Prior to the creation of HearColors Monica founded Perspectiva Integral, an international consulting firm. Monica has been a consultant for the Mexican government in issues related to telecommunications accessibility and has been rapporteur at the International Telecommunications Union of the access to telecommunications and ICT services for persons with disabilities since 2010. Monica has been a consultant for many organizations such as the ITU, OECD, APEC and the UN Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights in Mexico. Monica has a Phd in Political and Social Sciences from the Universidad Iberoamericana and a MSC in Economics and Philosophy from the London School of Economics.
