

DR. ALFONSO HERNÁNDEZ MAYA

Has more than 14 years of professional experience in the telecommunications and broadcasting sector. He currently holds the position of User Policy General Coordinator at the Federal Institute of Telecommunications. Previously, he served as Supervision General Director, which allowed him to understand in detail the obligations of the operators, and therefore, the protected rights for

the users.

In the extinct Cofetel, he became extensively acquainted with the operation of the institution as Technical Pro-Secretary of the Plenary, as well as with various aspects related to broadcasting, having also worked as head of the television concessions and permits department in the Radio and Television Systems Unit.

Holding a doctorate in Public Administration by the Anáhuac University together with the Sorbonne University of Paris, he is the first Mexican lawyer graduated from a Master's program in Telecommunications Law at the Francisco Vitoria University of Madrid, where on the occasion of his degree paper in 2005, he received an honorary mention in analyzing the problems and possible solutions for universal access to telecommunications services in Mexico.

In 2015, he worked as a developer of the Telecommunications Management Master's Degree at Anáhuac University, which is the first program that integrates the areas of economics, communication, law and engineering in a master's degree in the sector.

He is certified in top management by MIT and is currently doing a Master's Degree in Information Technologies at the University of Edinburgh.
