The airport Ministro Juan Pistarini (named Ezeiza, EZE) is located 40 minutes from the city of Buenos Aires and 79 km from La Plata. This airport is normally for international interconnections. Delegated can choose between different options to be transported their hotel in Buenos Aires:

Taxi: Several taxi companies are located at the exit of the international arrival of the airport.

Average cost Ezeiza – Ciudad de La Plata: \$ 1700

Minibus: A convenient option are mini bus scheduled every half hour to the main hotels.

Average transport cost Ezeiza – Ciudad de Buenos Aires: \$ 550 (minibus)

13. WORKING TIME

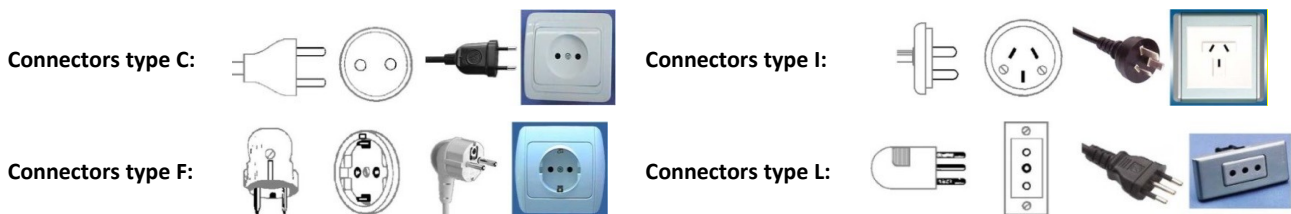
Banks and money Exchange centers are opened from Monday to Friday from 10 am until 3 pm. Comercial offices are opened from 9 am to 12 am and from 2 pm to 7 pm. Shoothing center are opened from 9 am to 8 pm. On Saturday, working time is from 9 am to 1 pm. Coffees and food delivery are opened the whole day except from two until six am. Restaurants offer lunchs from 12.30 pm and dinner is offered from 8:30 pm.

15. VOLTAGE

The voltage level in Argentina is 220 volts and 50 Hz. It is suggested guests bring their own power converters and wall plug adapters to allow use of international appliances. Commonly found electric plugs are of types C, F, I and L, with types L and F being the most common:
