Airport	The international airport in Antigua is the V.C. Bird International Airport (IATA code	
Information	ANU). Taxis are available as you exit Customs at the airport.	

Language	English is the official language in Antigua and Barbuda.		
Electricity supply	Part of the island is 110volts and the remainder is 220volts. Most hotels have both voltages available. If the voltage is different from your home country, some hotels offer adaptors to their guests or adaptors can be purchased from local hardware and electrical stores.		
Climate	Antigua weather is generally warm and sunny all year round with an average daytime high of 28°C / 82°F.		
Currency	The Eastern Caribbean dollar (EC) is the official currency of Antigua and Barbuda. While the US dollar is generally accepted, foreign currency can be exchanged at local banks and other authorised establishments. The most commonly accepted credit cards are VISA, Diners Club and MasterCard.		
	The average exchange rate is: US \$1.00 = EC \$2.65
