Ministro Juan Pistarini Airport (usually called Ezeiza, EZE, due to its location) is 40 minutes from the city of Buenos Aires. Used for international arrival and departure flights. Travelers have several transport options from the airport to their hotels in the City of Buenos Aires:

Remises and private taxis: The airport has a large number of taxi and remises companies, located at passengers exit.

Approximate rate from Ezeiza to City of Buenos Aires: \$ 500 (remis).

Minibuses: A cheaper alternative, every half hour with transfer services to the main downtown hotels.

Approximate rate from Ezeiza to City of Buenos Aires: \$ 550 (minibus).

Average temperature: 10° to 20° Celsius, in autumn.

13. BUSINESS HOURS

Banks and Money Exchange offices: Monday to Friday, 09:00 to 15:00 hrs.

Commercial offices: generally from 09:00 to 12:00 hrs and from 14:00 to 19:00 hrs.

Stores: from 09:00 to 20:00 hrs. On Saturdays, from 09:00 to 13:00 hrs.

Cafeterias, patisseries and pizzerias: they are almost always open, with a break between two and six in the morning.

Restaurants: lunch from 12.00 hrs and dinner from 20:30 hrs. Fast food establishments have a free schedule.

At cafeterias and restaurants it is used to leave a 10% of the bill, and also to give tips to bellboys.
