- **Current ETC Preparedness Projects**

- Madagascar, Bhutan, Mongolia, Mozambique, and the Pacific Islands
- We have historically engaged in Haiti and Domenica for preparedness/response support, and in the Caribbean for ET capacity development.

- **What we do**

- 1. Technical Assistance for National and Local Authorities**

- National operational readiness: reviewing systems/processes of national authority and providing recommendations.
- Holistic country assessment: considering national goals and national capabilities, including the private sector.
- Coordination: supporting authorities to set up an ICT coordination group.

- 2. Infrastructure Capacity Augmentation for National and Local Authorities**

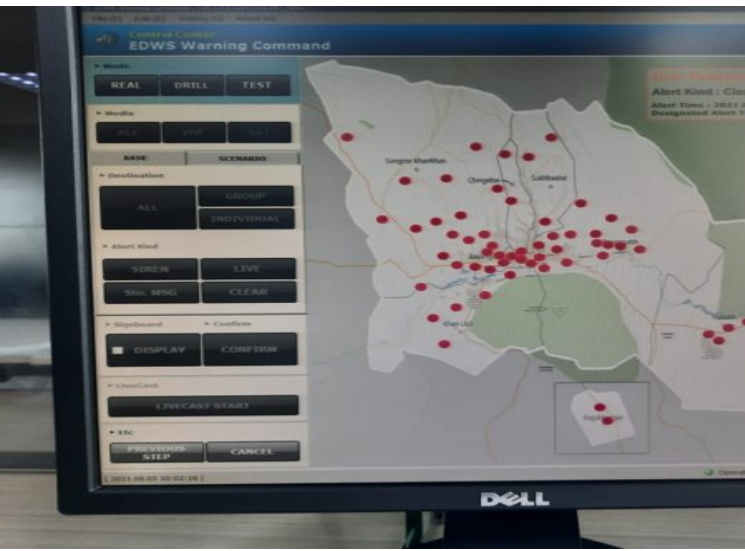
- 3. Training and Simulations for Governments, National and Local Authorities**

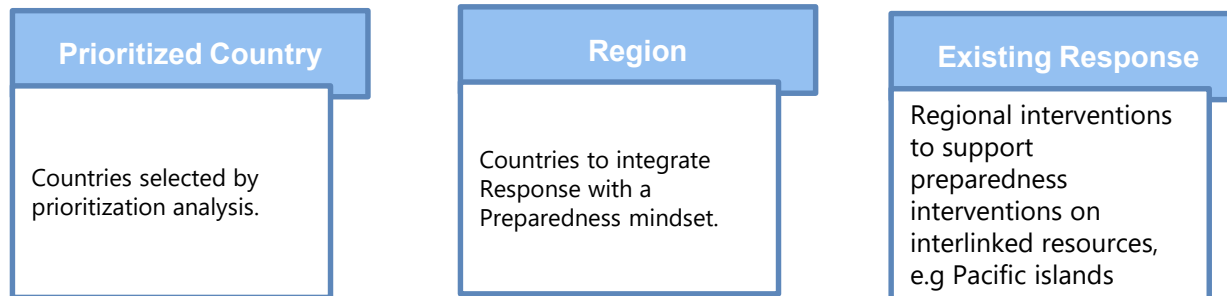

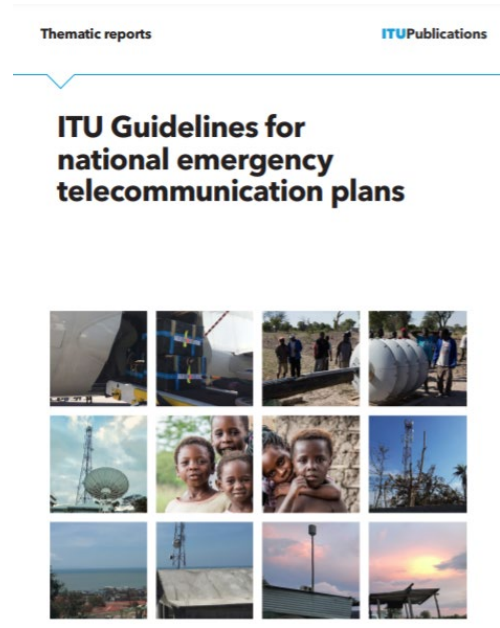
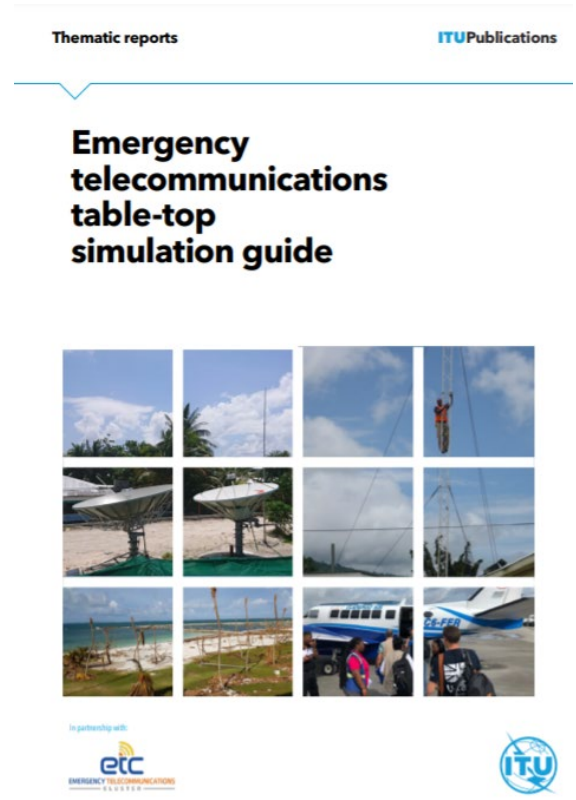
