- Formulate and launch project to establish a regional innovation center on Accessibility
- Develop online curriculum for the ITU Model ICT Accessibility Policy modules for delivery through ITU Academy

- Prepare guidelines on accessibility of PWDs to workshops, training courses, and conferences
