- Mr. Ali Abbassene is a Senior Researcher and Information System expert. Since 2016, he is the Director of the Telecom Division of CDTA research center (Algeria), and in 2014 he was the Chief Information Officer of CDTA. Since 2006, Ali took the lead of various R&D groups and managed many projects in the fields of information systems, healthcare informatics and telemedicine. He is working on B2B collaboration in the context of Web and semantic technologies, on inter-organizational workflow integration problems, and on IoT data-related standardization issues.
- In 2014, Ali represented CDTA, as contributor and editor in ITU-T SG13 "Future networks including cloud computing, mobile and NGN". Since 2015, Ali is representing Algeria (MPTTN) in ITU-T SG20, and in 2016 he was appointed as Associate Rapporteur of Question 2 on "IoT requirements, capabilities, and use cases across verticals" of ITU-T SG20 "IoT and smart cities and communities". Ali worked on various Recommendations involving IoT requirements for semantic technologies, Big Data, things description and business process management. He is Vice-Chairman of both Arab and African Regional Groups of SG20, and he acts as Liaison Rapporteur to the Joint Coordination Activity on ITM-2020 (5G). He is also participating in the work of the Arab Standardization Team (ASTEAM League of the Arab States).
