## Professor Sukil Kim

Sukil Kim is a professor at Chungbuk National University, Republic of Korea. He graduated from Seoul National University in 1975 and earned his PhD degree at North Carolina State University in 1989.

Since 1998, he has worked as an expert in ICT accessibility in Korea. He is currently serving as an accessibility consultant of Korean

government, and a national delegation of ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC35. He is the prime investigator of the Korean ICT accessibility standardization project.

During 2002-2013, He was Chair of Web Content Division, Information and Telecommunications Accessibility Promotion Standard Forum. During 2007~2013, He was the head of the Web Content Quality Mark Confirmation Committee of NIA (National Information Society Agency).

He has developed several standards and guidelines such as the Korean National Standard, Web content accessibility guidelines, 2.1(candidate), 2.0 and 1.0, Software accessibility guidelines 1.0, 2006, currently under revision, Web Content usability guidelines for persons with disabilities 1.0, 2011, Accessibility Guidelines for Accredited Certificate Subscriber Software, 2010, Electronic Document Accessibility Guidelines 1.0, 2007, and etc.

His major interests include, but not limited to ITC accessibility and human-computer interactions.
