I am pleased to invite you to participate in the First ICTD-ASP Asia-Pacific Regional Forum on Universal Access and Service and Broadband Deployment, which will be held on 25-27 March 2015 at Pullman Bangkok Kingpower Hotel, Thailand. The Forum is jointly organized by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), the Asian Development Bank (ADB), and the National Broadcasting and Telecommunications Commission of Thailand (NBTC), with support from the Department of Communications, Australian Government.

The Forum is the first of the series of annual regional forums on universal access and service and broadband deployment in the Asia-Pacific region under an ADB/ITU joint framework on ICT for Development in the Asia-Pacific region (ICTD-ASP). The Forum features three-day plenary meetings, focused group meetings, and exhibition. It is aimed to, inter alia:

- Provide a face-to-face platform for all relevant stakeholders to meet, discuss, share and exchange information, knowledge, and issues concerning Universal Access and Service as well as broadband deployment;
- Exhibit project cases under the framework of Universal Service Obligation;
- Strengthen the ICTD-ASP partnership framework among member countries, relevant stakeholders and potential partners;
- Promote an establishment of a network of USO policy makers so as to update and exchange information among each other;
- Provide a forum for ICTD-ASP stakeholders and potential partners to discuss about potential projects that may be implemented under the ICTD-ASP framework.

The Forum targets policy makers, national regulatory authorities, practitioners, scholars, financiers, public and private sector including NGOs and the civil society and all other relevant stakeholders in making, implementing, and promoting the Universal Access and Service and/or National Broadband Policy in their respective countries or internationally.
