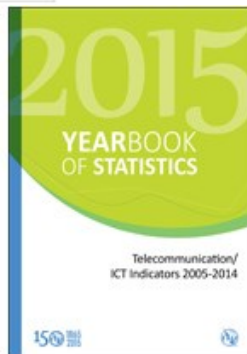
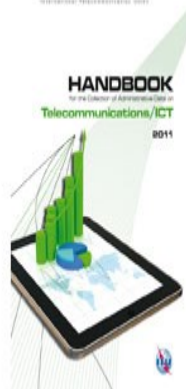
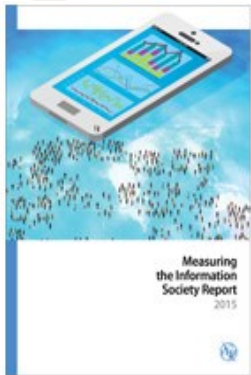

Capacity Building on ICT Statistics



- Resolution 8 on Collection and Dissemination of Information and Statistics, calls on ITU to among others, “provide technical assistance to the relevant national authorities for the collection and dissemination of ICT statistics...”

ITU is the official source for global ICT statistics. It relies primarily on information provided by Member States, thus making it also its mandate to strengthen the capacity of our member administrations.
