The International Telecommunication Union (ITU) is organizing the ITU Regional Development Forum for Asia-Pacific Region on "*ICTs for Sustainable Development Goals*" (RDF-ASP 2018) that will be held on 21-22 May 2018 at the Sukosol Bangkok Hotel, Thailand. The RDF-ASP 2018 is kindly hosted by the Ministry of Digital Economy and Society (MDES), Thailand.

The objective of the Forum is to provide an opportunity for high-level dialogue between the Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) and decision-makers, governments and regulators, of ITU Member States, Sector Members and Academia. The RDF-ASP 2018 will focus on the implementation of the Buenos Aires Action Plan (BaAP), with particular emphasis on the Asia-Pacific Regional Initiatives (ASP-RI) 2018-2021 and invites feedback, proposals and recommendations to adjust as well as contribute to the BDT's work in the Asia-Pacific region in the next operational cycle.
