Ms Jonghwi Park leads the regional programme on ICT in Education at UNESCO Asia Pacific Regional Bureau for Education, supporting 48 Member States of the region. Her team at UNESCO Bangkok focuses on policy-level supports for Member States, including ICT national policy reviews, ICT in education master plan development and regional comparative research on the current issues, with special emphasis on the role of ICT to facilitate the achievement of SDG4 or Education 2030 agenda. Current projects include 1) policy support (ICT in Education policy and planning) for Bhutan, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka and Solomon Islands; 2) national ICT competency standards development for teachers for Philippines, Uzbekistan, Mongolia, Nepal and Myanmar; and 3) regional framework development for measuring digital citizenship competencies. She obtained her Master's degree in Educational Technology from Hanyang University, Korea and her PhD in Learning Sciences from McGill University, Canada.
