- Coordinate on regional voice/position for the Asia-Pacific region at global events

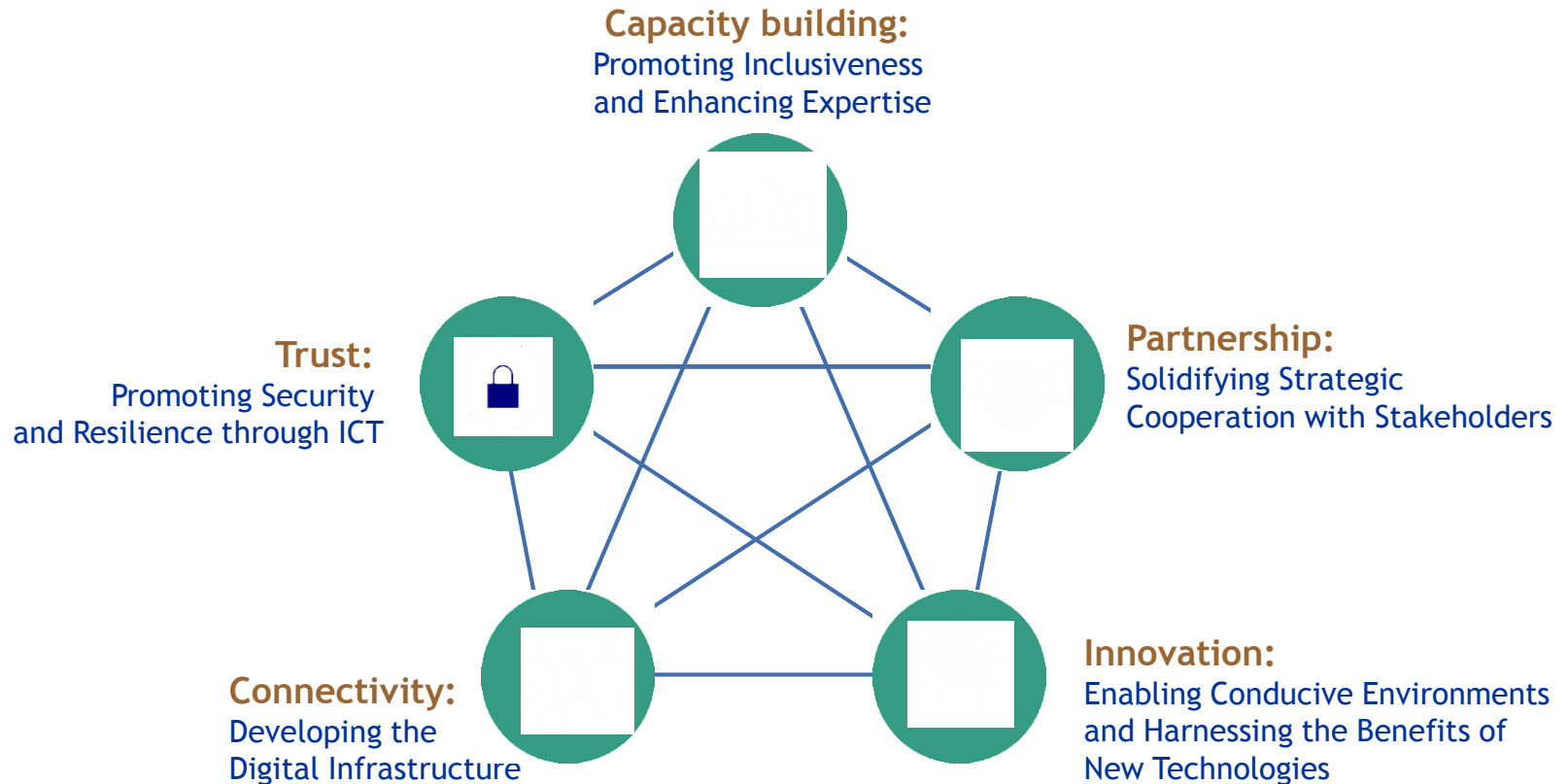
# APT membership

(Open to any Enterprise, Agency, Institute, Organization, Academia, etc. active in Telecommunication/ ICT area in the region)

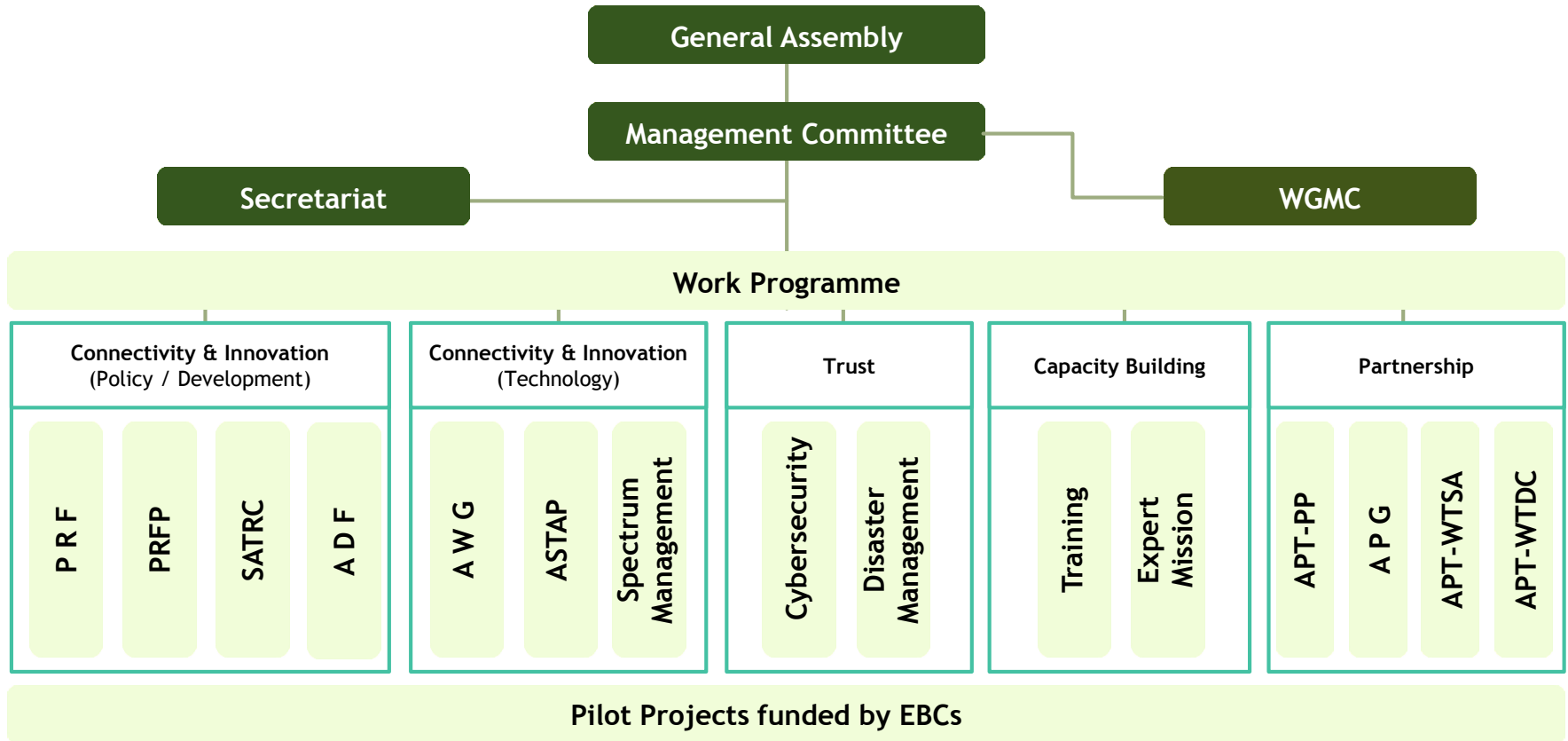

- ✓ APT commenced its works in Aug 2016 to assist its membership to prepare for WTDC-17;
- ✓ Set up APT Preparatory Group for ITU WTDC-17 - **APT WTDC-17**
- ✓ Objectives of the APT WTDC-17:
  - ✓ To assist APT Members to prepare for the World Telecommunication Development Conference in coordinating issues of regional interest and the submission of regional contributions to the Conference;
  - ✓ To develop proposals from APT Members that considers the interest of the Asia-Pacific region as inputs for WTDCs;
  - ✓ To develop inputs from APT Members for ITU Regional Preparatory Meeting (RPM) for Asia and the Pacific;
  - ✓ To assist APT Members during the WTDC.

  - # 2: Review the WRC Agenda Items and start to develop APT Preliminary Views on Agenda Items
  - # 3: Consider the ITU-R Studies and update APT Preliminary Views on Agenda Items
  - # 4: Consider final result of ITU-R Studies, update APT Preliminary Views on Agenda Items and develop APT contributions to CPM-2
  - # 5: Develop Preliminary APT Common Proposals (PACPs) for WRC

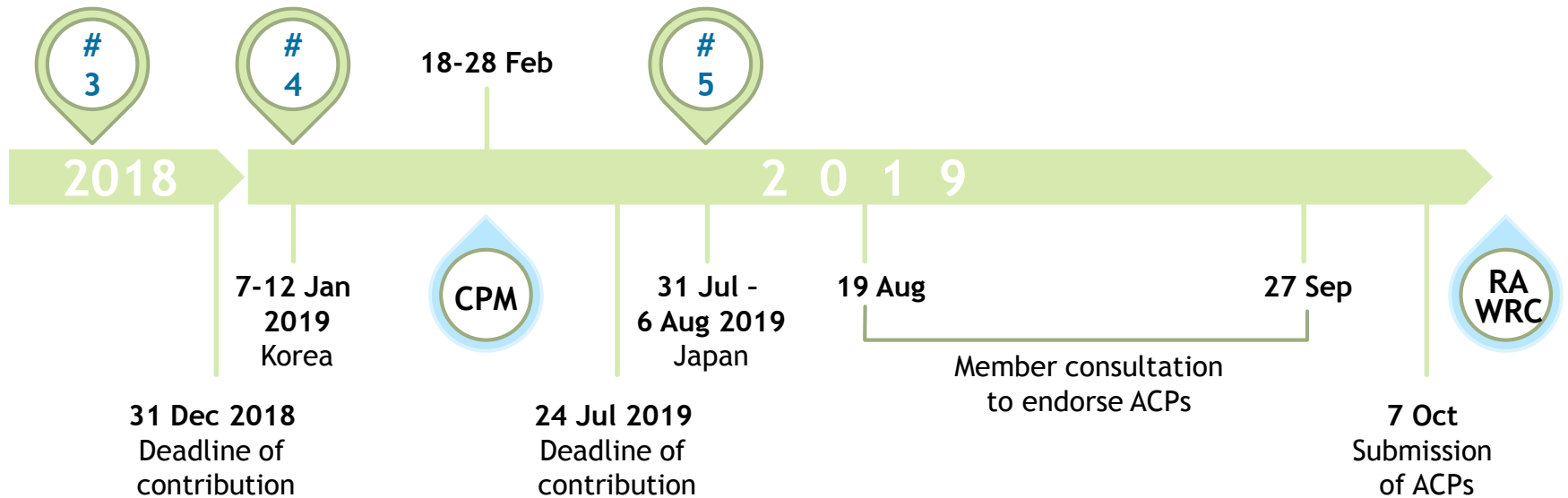
