- Resolution 131 Measuring information and communication technologies to build an integrating and inclusive information society (Rev. Dubai, 2018) – the main Resolution determined the work of ITU on the statistics in the field of telecommunications/ICT
- Firstly approved on ITU Plenipotentiary Conference 2006
- Operational part of Resolution always advancing in each version of revisions, mainly on the instructions for the Director of the Telecommunication Development Bureau



- A four-year period of validity for the structure and methodology of the ICT development index and ICT price baskets was established
- Operational part of Resolution always advancing in each version of revisions, mainly on the instructions for the Director of the Telecommunication Development Bureau
- **New Section** *instructs the study groups of the ITU Telecommunication Development Sector*




- From methodology to practice

- Requirements on systematical report for Council on the implementation of Resolution 131 were set
- Secretary-General should examine the necessary human and financial resources required in all the ITU Bureaux to conduct ITU's work in gathering, producing and publishing meaningful data, information, statistics and reports, and inform the Council of the results of this study
