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About project

- ✓ Development of Multimedia online course on digital skills for women and girls
- ✓ Project duration: August – December 2020

Project primary goals

- ✓ Development of online training platform: <https://iktlab.edu.az/>
- ✓ Development of multimedia online course on digital skills: **2 courses / 16 modules**
- ✓ Train persons: **initially 50 females** will participate in trainings with providing feedback

Project future goals

- ✓ Increase the number of courses and add IT professional courses like programming
- ✓ Provide class-based trainings in regions through 18 branches of ICT LAB

Rational of the project

Statistical analyze of the situation

- ✓ Only **32% is women** of total workers in ICT sector
- ✓ Women in ICT sector mostly work as non-ICT specialists
- ✓ Only **12%** of female students study in **STEM disciplines**
- ✓ Digital divide among country regions and genders:
 - All regions have only **54%** (excluding Baku with 46%) of all **any types of computers** in the country whereas the distribution for **rural areas are 23.8%**
 - Internet access problem: the main reasons of internet unavailability are **insufficient finance to buy computer (40.3%)** and **lack of skills (23.1%)**.
 - Limited female ICT education in regions happens because of **language barrier**. People has difficulties to use foreign language resources. Unfortunately, online resources for digital skills development in Azeri language are limited.

Trainings

- ✓ E-Learning portals are published and open for users. We will collect first feedback by the end of December
- ✓ We have already provided real trainings (Online due to the Covid19) based on the multimedia course and 50 females participated in the trainings

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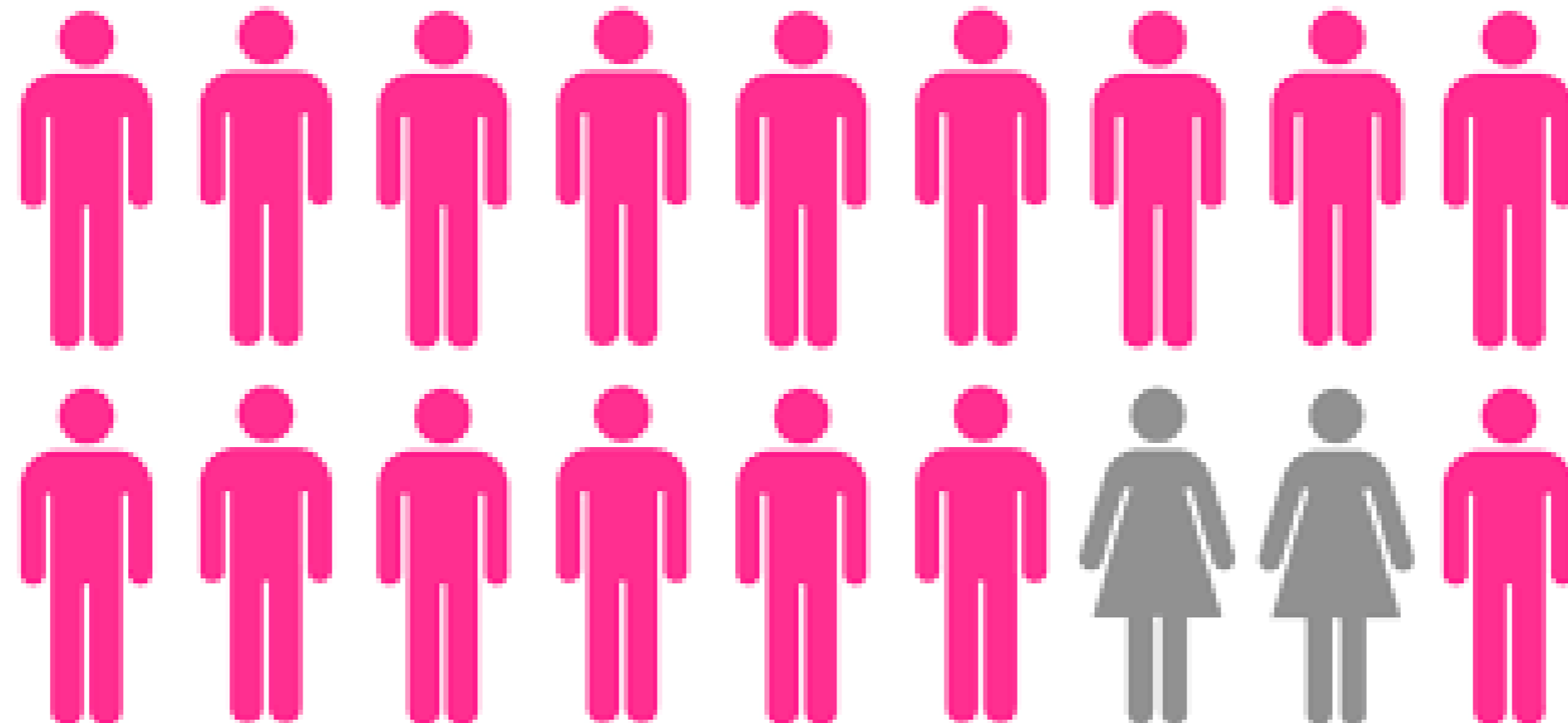
