7. Currency/exchange/credit cards

National currency unit in the Republic of Uzbekistan is Uzbekistan sum (UZS). All payments are made in national currency. Currency exchange offices and banks are available in all cities.

As of 15 March 2023, the exchange rate of the UZS was:

1 USD = 11 427,84 UZS, 1 Euro = 12 265,71 UZS.

8. Climate


Uzbekistan has a sharply continental climate, which is characterized by a large difference between day and night temperatures. Temperatures fluctuate greatly depending on the time of year. The average daily temperature in the second half of May is about +27 °C, at night the temperature drops to +14 °C.

10. Electric devices

Voltage power is 220V / 50 Hz. Electric outlets are Type C and Type F.



11. Communication means

There are three fixed line telephony providers working in Uzbekistan: JS "Uzbektelecom", JV "Est Telecom", JV "Buzton". Mobile communication is provided by Uzdunrobita – trade mark "MTS" (GSM), Unitel – trade mark "Beeline" (GSM), Coscom – trade mark «U-cell» (GSM), UzMobile (CDMA 450).

Telephone code of Tashkent is +998 71. A local call from a regular phone will cost around 12 sum per minute. For international calls from Tashkent, the international calling procedure is applied (dial 00 + code of the country + code of the city+ subscriber's number or follow instructions defined on prepaid cards). The Workshop participants can get Internet access in the respective hotels and at the events' venue.

12. Visa

Participants who require a visa to enter the Republic of Uzbekistan should contact the Embassy/Consulate of the Republic of Uzbekistan in their country in advance in order to get information. The Republic of Uzbekistan has established a bilateral international agreement and parity on a bilateral visa-free regime with the Republic of Azerbaijan, Georgia, Republic of Armenia, Republic of Belarus, Republic of Kazakhstan, Republic of Moldova, Russian Federation, Ukraine, Kyrgyz Republic (up to 60 days) and Republic of Tajikistan (up to 30 days). 13. General information

The Republic of Uzbekistan is located between the rivers of Amudarya and Syrdarya and occupies 447,400 square meters. The span of the territory from the west to the east is 1,425 km and from the north to the south - 930 km. Republic of Uzbekistan is bordered by five landlocked countries: the Republic of Kazakhstan to the north; the Republic of Tajikistan he southeast; the Kyrgyz Republic to the northeast; Afghanistan to the south; and Turkmenistan to the southwest.
