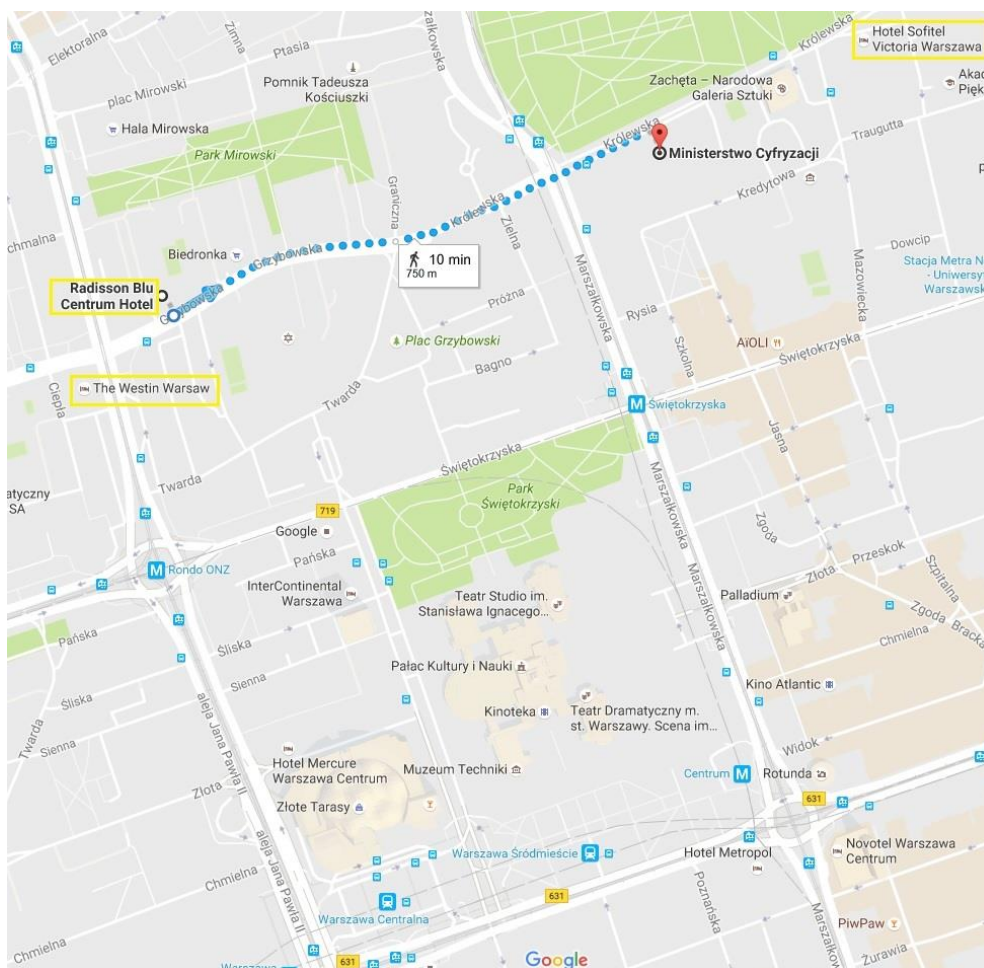

HOW TO GET TO THE MINISTRY





Taxi service: for safety reasons we strongly advise you to use licensed taxi services offered at the Chopin Airport Arrivals. Taxi tariffs should be clearly displayed in one of the car's rear side windows.

Taxi fares from the airport to the city round **40 PLN** and the trip takes c. 20 minutes. Please note that heavy traffic can double this estimation.

Bus: the bus no. **175** operates between Warsaw Chopin Airport and City Center daily between 04:27am - 10:58pm. The trip takes c. 30 minutes. Please note that heavy traffic is likely to cause delays.

Route: Take the bus 175 from the Chopin Airport to central Warsaw (bus stop "Centrum 05"), then change to any tram headed to "Bielany" direction (trams no. 4, 15, 18, 35). Get off on the Królewska tram stop (2 tram stops away). The Ministry of Digital Affairs is within walking distance (c. 2-3 min.)

Train: the **S2** train can also take you from Warsaw Chopin Airport to the central part of the city. It operates between 6:05am-11:05pm. The trip takes c. 20 minutes.

Route: get the S2 train at Warsaw Chopin Airport and get off at the station "Warszawa Śródmieście". Walk to the nearest tram stop ("Centrum 08", c. 2-minutes' walk) and take any of the trams mentioned before.

Please also note that **Uber** operates in Warsaw. You are equally more than welcome to use the city **bike rental system**, Veturilo (<https://en.veturilo.waw.pl/>).

TRANSPORTATION

Participants are kindly requested to make their own international travel arrangements to and from Warsaw.

CURRENCY

The official Polish currency unit is "polski złoty", abbreviated as PLN. Foreign currencies may be changed into PLN at banks, private exchange offices (called "Kantor" in Polish; they usually offer better rates than most banks), or hotels. Major travel cheques can be cashed and all major credit cards are widely accepted. Official exchange rate of PLN against foreign currencies could be found on www.nbp.pl/Kursy/KursyC.html

CREDIT CARDS

Most hotels, restaurants, car rental agencies, department stores and shops accept all major credit & debit cards (American Express, Visa, Eurocard, MasterCard).
