Executive Training on the Role of ICTs in the Development of Inclusive Society for Persons with Disabilities, will be held in Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina, on 5 December 2017. The executive training is organized by the Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) in cooperation with the UN Mission in Bosnia and Herzegovina and Communications Regulatory Agency of Bosnia and Herzegovina (CRA) within the framework of the ITU Regional Initiative for Europe on Ensuring access to telecommunications/ICTs, in particular for persons with disabilities, adopted by the World Telecommunication Development Conference 2014 (WTDC-14), Dubai.

The executive training aims at building capacity building and supporting stakeholders in their efforts to make ICT/TV/Video programming accessible to Persons with Disabilities in line with ITU standards and guidelines thereby deepening understanding and developing knowledge of core areas of accessible ICT/TV/Video programming for Persons with Disabilities.

It is aimed at senior staff members of relevant governmental institutions, national regulatory authorities, ICT industry representatives, audiovisual media, content producers, service providers, academia and civil society, this national level training for Bosnia and Herzegovina will include expertled presentations, case studies and practical demonstration of how to implement accessibility services in TV/Video programming. The training is devised following previous assessments and responds to the national circumstances in Bosnia and Herzegovina, to develop an inclusive society for persons with disabilities.

The executive training is free of charge and will be delivered in the official languages that are in use in Bosnia and Herzegovina.
