Background

Montenegro is currently in the process of transiting from IPv4 to IPv6.

Proposal

In line with the objectives of the Regional Initiative One, that amongst other things aims at providing technical assistance in enhancing telecommunication infrastructure, including support for quality-of-service monitoring systems, national IXP deployment and transition from IPv4 to IPv6, EKIP proposes the following:

1. To continue collaboration with ITU on the establishment of the testing laboratory for IPV6. ITU's assistance would be appreciated in regard to this migration, giving training on the policy and regulation component as well as organising a laboratory, hands-on training on the IPV6 migration.
2. To organize 3 days Forum on transition from IPv4 to IPv6 targeting all countries from South Eastern Europe. Forum might take place within the framework of the INFOFEST 2020 and be held back to back with the ITU-EKIP Regional Regulatory Forum for Europe, scheduled for 28-29 September 2020.
