National Authority for Electronic Certification and Cyber Security (NAECCS) has the responsibility of overseeing the enforcement of Law Nr.9880/2008 "For Electronic Signature", of Law Nr.107/2015 "For Electronic Identification and Trusted Services" and Law Nr. 2/2017 "For Cyber Security" and under law acts that have been issued for their appliance. NAECCS is established on May 2017 and is national CSIRT and coordinator between all stakeholder in country and international homologues. In order to increase the level of cyber security in the country, the Government of the Republic of Albania must meet the following goals:

- Ensuring cyber security at the national level, through the protection of information infrastructure, by strengthening technological and legal means.
- Building a secure cyber environment, raising public awareness and building professional capacity.



- Creating the necessary mechanisms for children's safety in cyberspace, while preparing the new generation capable of taking advantage of information technology priorities and facing development challenges.
- Increasing national and international cooperation in the field of cyber security with strategic partners.

In order to fulfill these goals, a National Strategy for Cyber security, together with Action Plan, is drafted and in the approval process.

In order to fulfil the obligation derived from Law 2/2017:

- it is necessary to implement the project “Establishment of National AL-CSIRT” which is proposed and elaborated together with ITU and presented at “Final report on Assessment of Cyber security level in Albania”
- to enhance cyber security awareness in Albania and foster cyber security capacities in Albania through different action as :
 - Cyberdrill events for cyber security experts at CII and other, as well as students (June – October 2020)
 - TTX for raising protections and responsive skills of CII CSIRT’s teams
 - Albania CyberSecurity Academy
 - Awareness campaign on secure internet for citizens’, public administration, businesses , children
 - Safer Internet Day / Women 4 Cyber
 - European Cyber Security Month
