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

Balkan Barometer 2020

- Importance expressed by: close to 80% of managers in WB; 73% for micro-companies; 92% for large companies)
- Actions undertaken: 55% of companies provide some form of training in digital skills;
- <u>Necessity</u>: Digital skills is one of two topical areas where most employers expect improvement



Way forward

- Through CRM Action Plan WB committed to have:
 - Coordinated regional response to digital skills;
 - Balanced approach between national and regional needs;
 - Develop digital skills strategies & tailor-made actions (i.e. dedicated training programs, coaching, mentoring, etc.);

RCC role and support



- Established permanent regional dialogue in digital skills;
- Networked WB institutions engaged in digital skills;
- Exposed WB to the work of other organizations;
- Defined the digital skills agenda until 2024;
- 2021 and onward:
 - Fully-fledged assessment of gaps and needs;
 - Support policy formulation and regional actions
 - Peering and networking in a structured manner;
 - Showcasing and experience sharing on regular basis;
