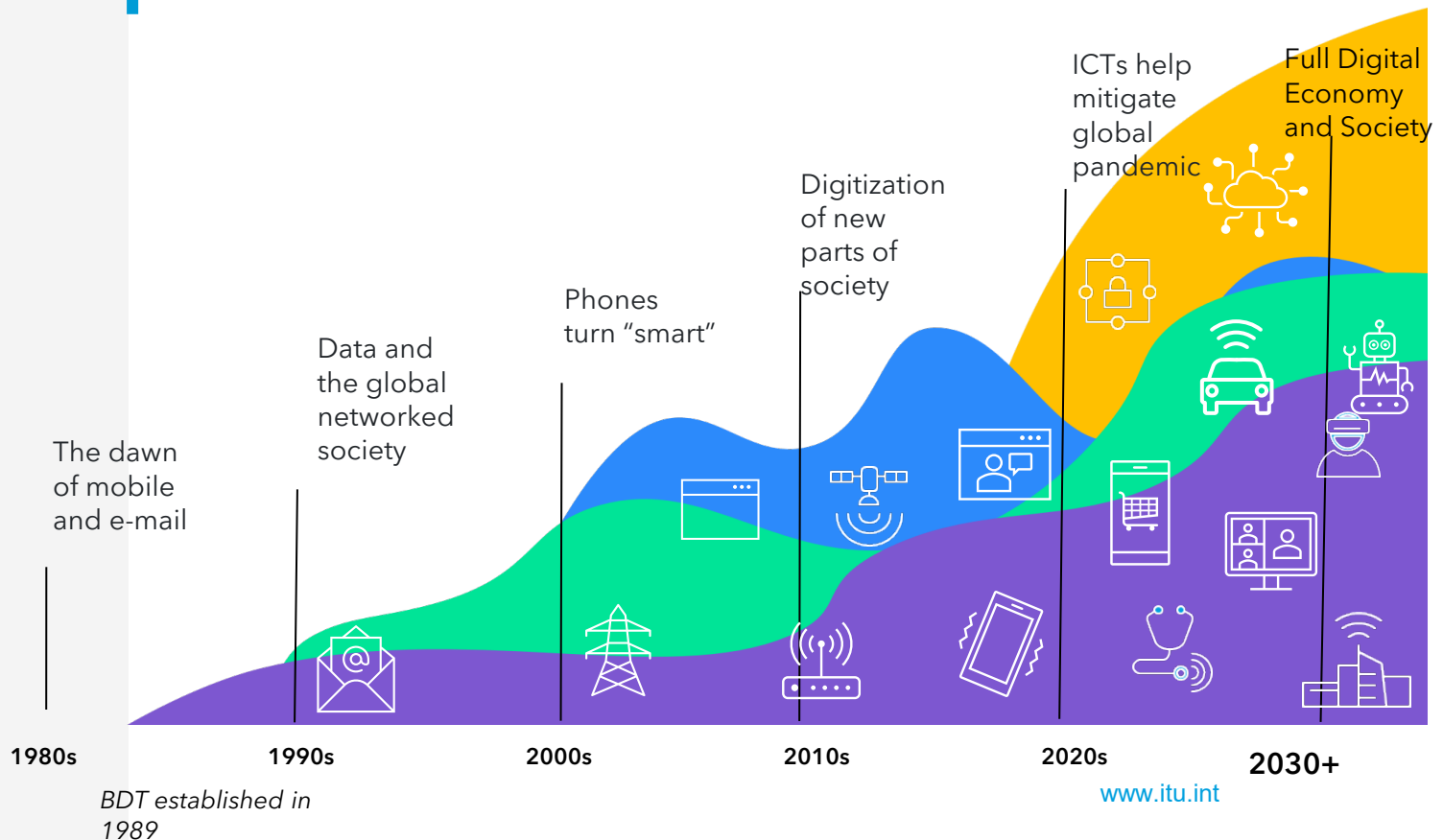

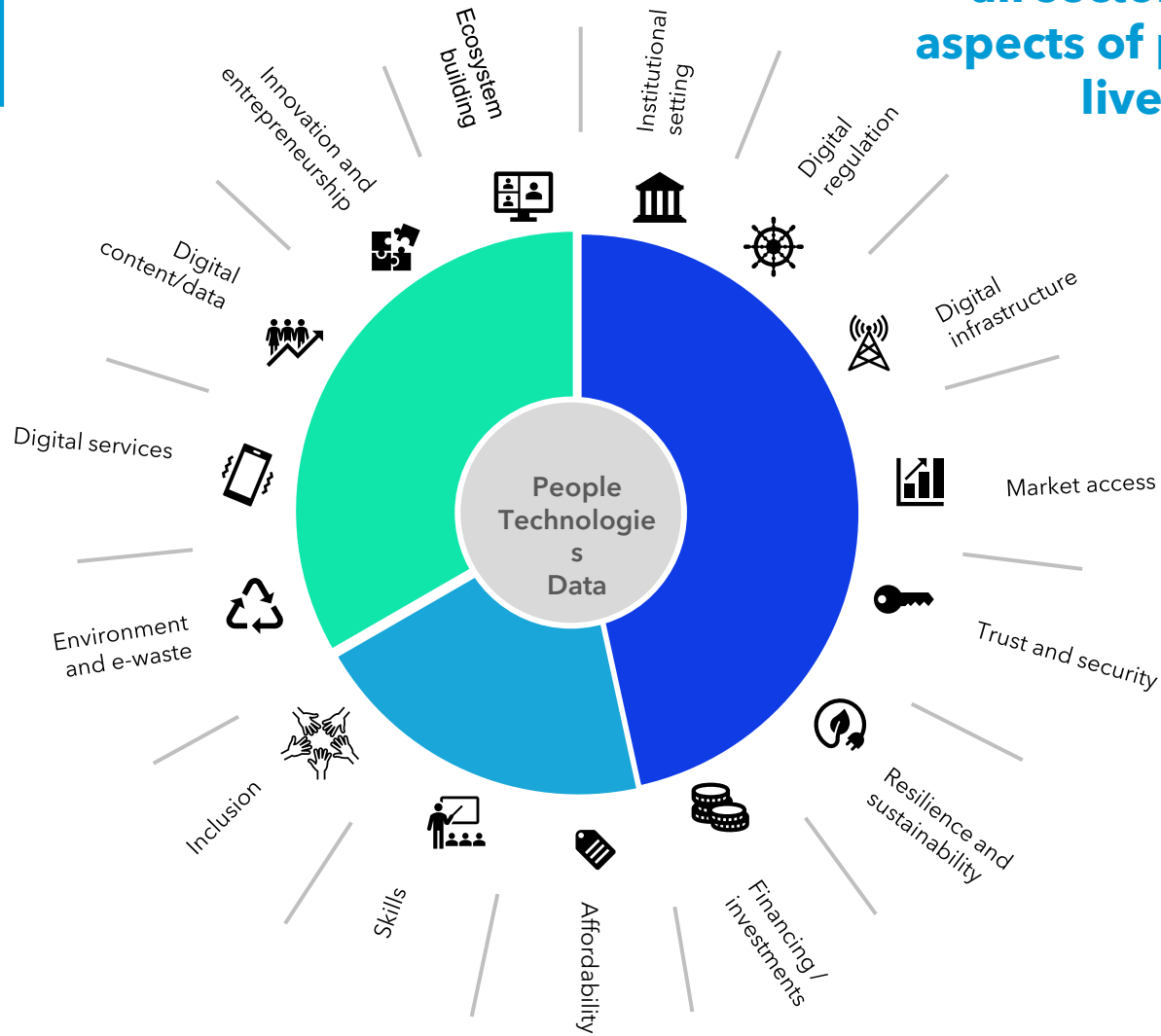

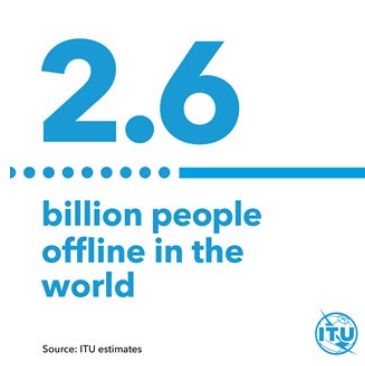

5.4 billion people are now online...



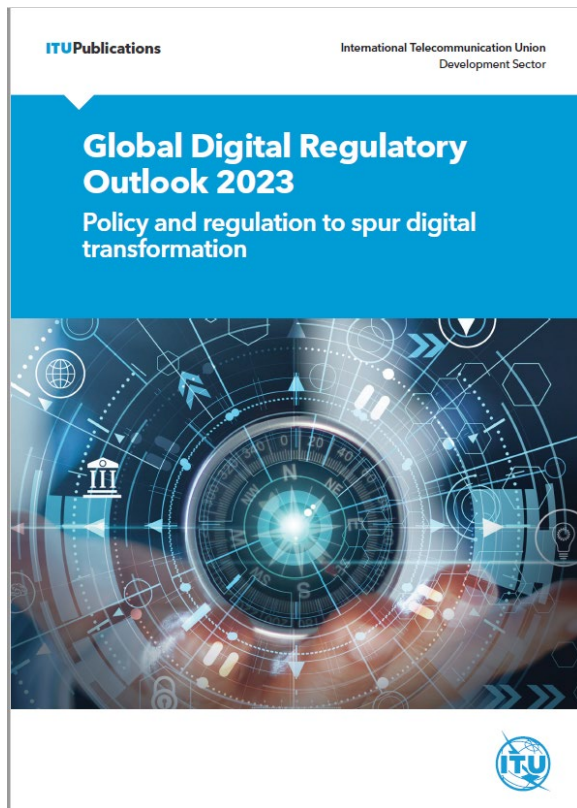

# Digital is the new normal

According to various estimates:

- Around 70% of **new value** created in the economy over the next decade will be based on digitally enabled platform business models;
- The global digital transformation **market** is expected to grow more than twice by 2025 (if compared to 2020);
- The global **investment** in digital transformation is expected to almost double between the years 2022 from 1.8 trillion USD and 2025 to 2.8 trillion USD.

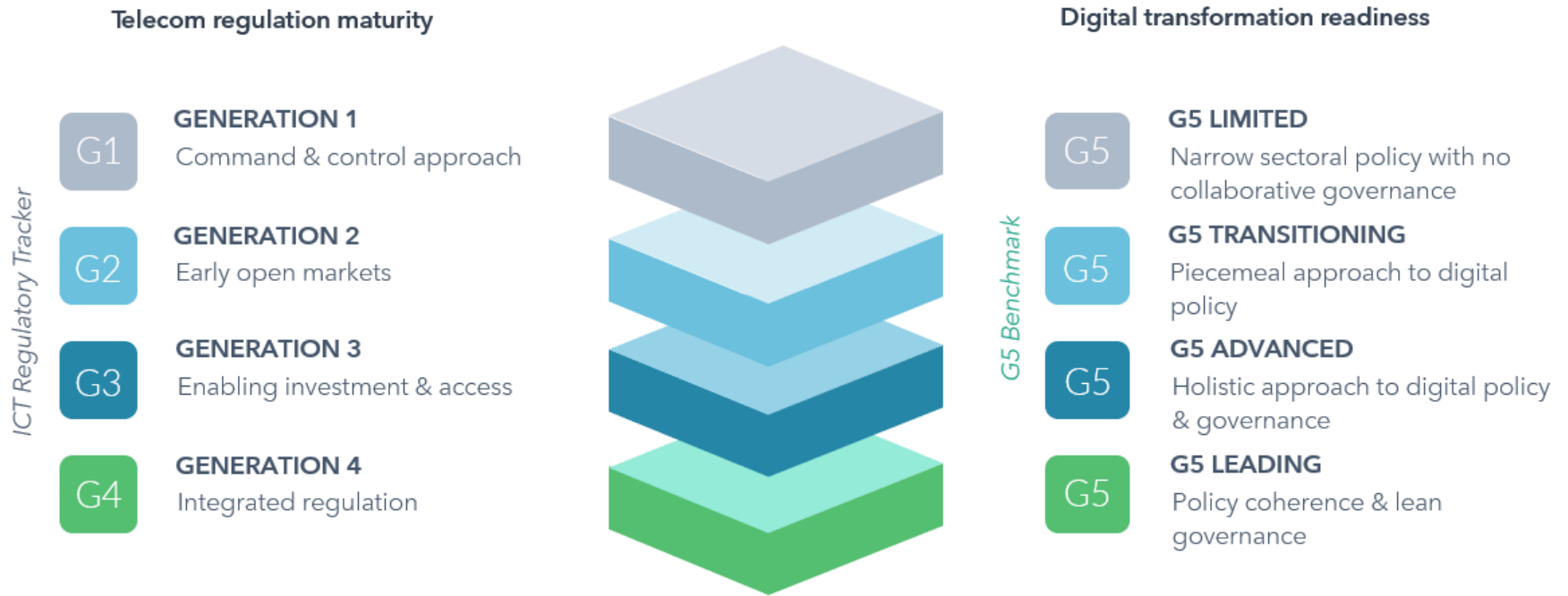

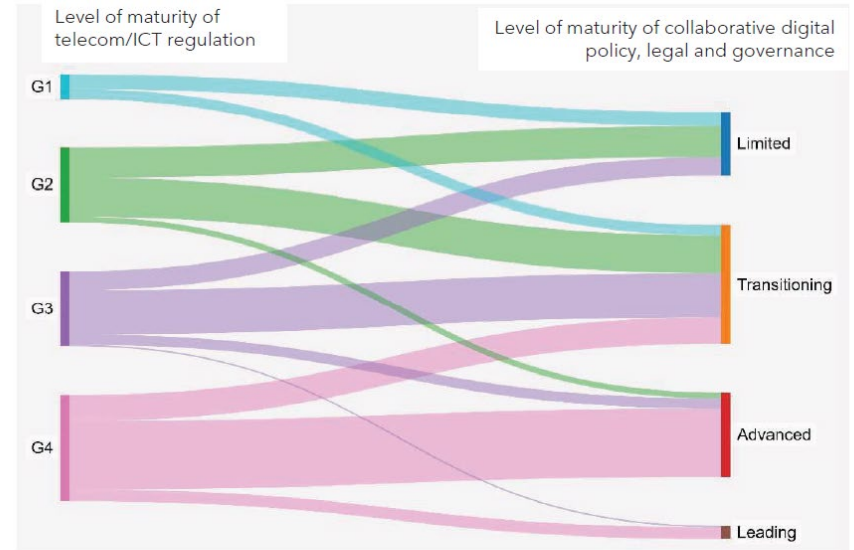
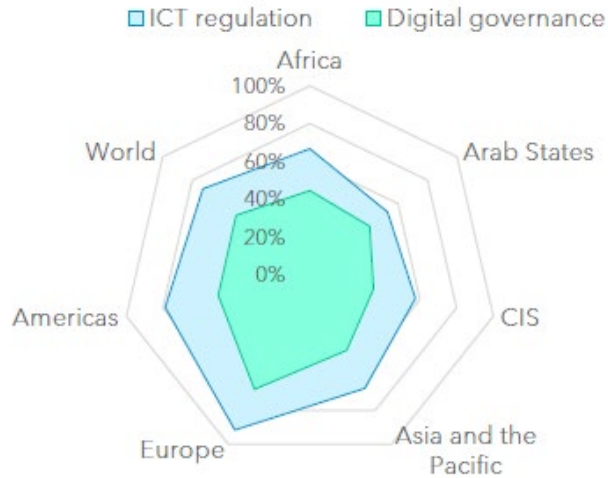

## Overall maturity of national policy, legal and institutional frameworks, by region, 2022

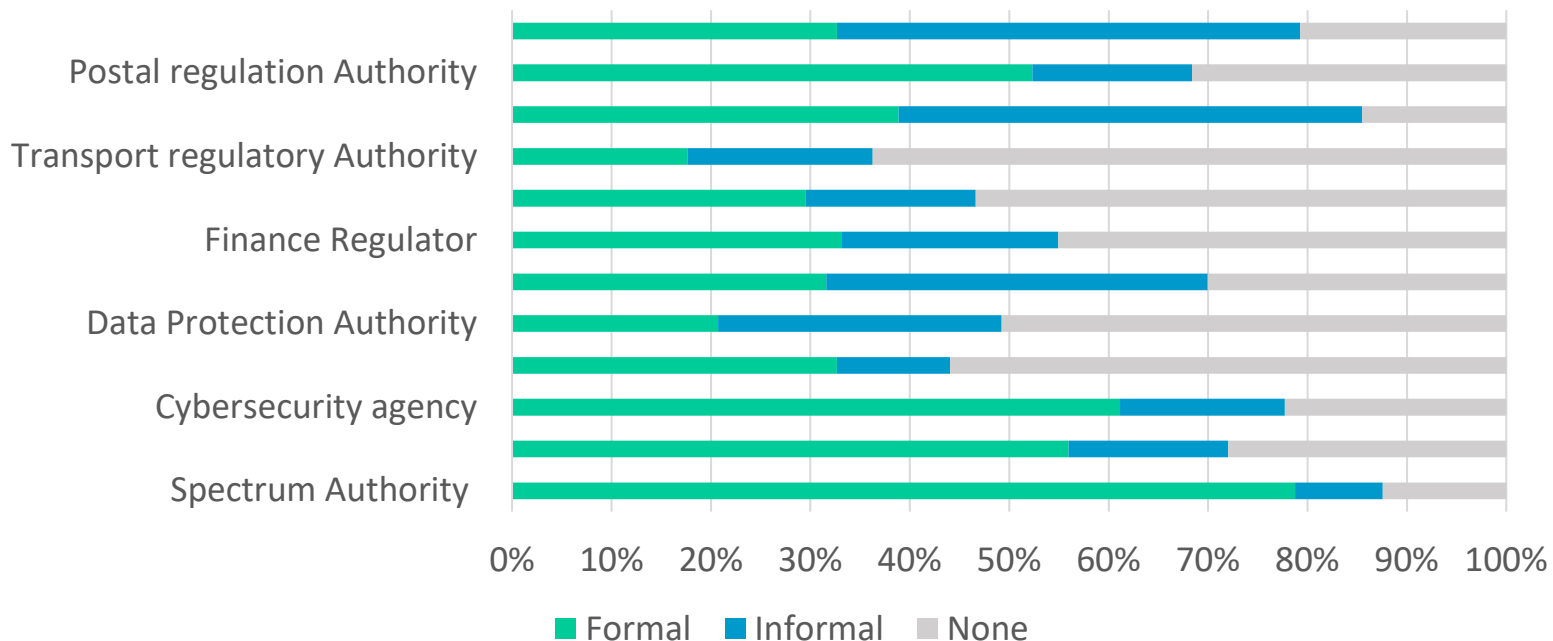
