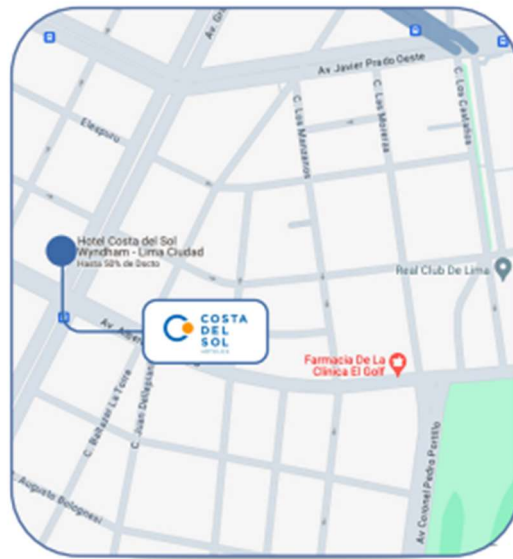

b. Transport

**Lima Airport**

Jorge Chávez International Airport ([www.lima-airport.com](http://www.lima-airport.com)) is located in the Constitutional Province of Callao, located 10 kilometres from the centre of Lima.

c. Location

The city of Lima is located on the west-central coast of Peru and is adjacent to the Pacific Ocean. The center of Lima is at an altitude of 161 meters above sea level.

d. Climate

In the month of September, the average temperature in the city of Lima fluctuates between 18 to 23 °C. Light drizzle may be possible. For more information, check the country's official climatology website: <http://www.senamhi.gob.pe/>

e. Coin

The official currency in Peru is the Sol (S/ or PEN). It is issued in banknotes of 10, 20, 50, 100 and 200 soles; and in coins of 0.10, 0.20 and 0.50 cents of a sol and in 1, 2 and 5 soles. Since 2021, a new family of banknotes has been in circulation, which circulate simultaneously with previous editions. Below, you will find the denominations currently in circulation.



At the airport and in various places in the city there are exchange offices, where you can convert foreign currency into SOLES. However, the dollar is an accepted currency in many commercial establishments. The exchange rate can vary between S/. 3.7 and S/. 3.8. The most frequently accepted credit cards are: American Express, VISA and Master Card.

The time reference in Peru is: UTC-5.

g. [Electric current](#)

The voltage used in Peru is 220 Volts (AC), 60Hz and the plugs are flat two and three pin American type. While in most hotels the plugs are prepared to accept both types of plugs, it may be a good idea to bring an adapter plug.

**Business hours:**

1. **Commercial Stores:** They are usually open from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
2. **Bank and exchange offices:** They are open from Monday to Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

**Tips:** It is customary to leave 10% of the amount of the service in cafes and restaurants.
