

#### **Background:**

- Previous editions: 1994 and 2011
- Revisions made to indicators in the EGTI meeting
- New indicators agreed in the EGTI meeting

#### **Objective:**


 to have a comprehensive and useful reference for all countries when measuring telecom/ICT, to ensure international comparability of the data



- Launched online on 25 August 2020
- Covers over 90 indicators on telecommunication/ICT services
- Covers data collected from administrative sources (e.g. telecom operators)
- Discussed in the ITU Expert Group on Telecom/ICT Indicators (EGTI)

- EGTI discussed and approved since 2011 a number of indicators, the Handbook:
  - Includes new indicators (fixed network coverage, Internet traffic, spectrum)
  - Includes revision and clarifications for existing indicators (ICT prices, fixed broadband, revenues and investment, international bandwidth, mobile broadband, ....)
  - Old indicators were kept for historical purposes or country data collection purposes



- 1. Improved text on the scope of indicators
- 2. Includes **indicators approved by the EGTI meeting** in the last 8 years
- Provides updated country examples on how to collect the indicators
- 4. Introduces Relevance for the indicator
