At the kind invitation of the Ministry for Public Service, Information and Broadcasting of St. Lucia, the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), in partnership with the Eastern Caribbean Telecommunications Authority (ECTEL), is pleased to invite your organization to participate in the **Regional Training Workshop on Information and Communication Technology Indicators** to be held from 24-27 February 2014, in Gros Islet, St. Lucia. The workshop is organized by Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) in collaboration with, and supported by, the Eastern Caribbean Telecommunications Regulatory Authority (ECTEL).

The objective of the workshop is to strengthen the capacity of countries in the region to produce national statistics and indicators on telecommunications and ICT. The workshop will present an overview of the work on ICT measurement undertaken globally by the ICT Data and Statistics Division, ITU/BDT, including the ICT Development Index and the ICT Price Basket; discuss the main groups of telecommunication/ICT indicators collected by ITU, their definitions and methodological issues; the dissemination and harmonization of ICT data at the international level; data collection/ITU questionnaires; ITU manuals; as well as mechanisms for the national coordination of ICT statistics. Also, the participants will have the opportunity to share the experience of their countries in the collection, harmonization and coordination of telecommunication/ICT indicators.

While there is no registration fee, all expenses of the workshop participants are to be covered by the participating organization.
