



History of ITU statistics





Mandate of ITU statistical work

- World Telecommunication
 Development Conference (WTDC)
 - Resolution 8 (Rev. Buenos Aires, 2017)

- ITU Plenipotentiary Conference 2018 (PP-18)
 - > Resolution 131 (Rev. Dubai, 2018)



Resolution 131 (rev. Dubai 2018)

- promote adoption of ICT statistics and composite indices developed by ITU
- 2. rely on official data provided by Member States based on internationally recognized and transparent methodologies,
- 3. start data collection at the beginning of the year, and publish within three months
- 4. publish annually the IPB and the IDI...
- 5. ... not retroactively updated or amended post publication
- 6. develop and maintain advanced visualization and analysis tools
- 7. develop a toolkit to assist members in establishing national statistical frameworks
- 8. liaise with other prominent international organizations
- 9. define and adopt new indicators for the purpose of measuring the impact of ICTs
- 10. timely and transparent dissemination of the internationally agreed ICT methodologies and comparable indicators



Resolution 131 (rev. Dubai 2018)

../..

- 11. review, revise and further develop benchmarking
- 12. maintain a group of experts on ICT indicators and statistics (EGTI and EGH)
- 13. hold the World Telecommunication/ICT Indicators Symposium (WTIS) and expert group meetings (EGTI/EGH) periodically
- 14. monitor the development and improvement of methodologies particularly by means of EGH, EGTI and WTIS
- 15. publish IDI and IPB calculation methodologies, structures and data on the ITU website
- 16. hold regular regional seminars and training events for developing countries
- 17. implement WTDC Resolution 8 (Rev. Buenos Aires, 2017)
- 18. strengthen partnerships and collaboration
- 19. identify approaches for members to provide regular inputs on the development and analysis of statistics and indicators
- 20. to submit a report to the Council on progress in the implementation of this resolution (especially on the IDI and IPB)
