World Radiocommunication Conferences (WRCs)

- Updated the Radio Regulations,
 the international treaty on the use of radio spectrum and satellite orbits
- Brought together all stakeholders in a process that is aimed at building consensus
- Provided a stable and predictable regulatory environment needed for future investments
- Enabled new radiocommunication systems and applications to access the radio spectrum
- Protected the operation of existing radiocommunication services
- Ensured the rational, equitable, efficient and economical use of the radio-frequency spectrum and satellite-orbit resources

 - Spectrum Allocation



- Administrative and operational procedures
- ✓ Adopts Resolutions
- ✓ Held every 3-4 years (CS* 90)



Worldwide or Regional Spectrum Harmonization




Benefits:

- Reduces the potential for harmful interference
- Enables interoperability and international roaming, allowing citizens to use the same device in different countries
- Increases economies of scale, thereby enabling affordable devices and services
- Supports emergency communications





- ⇒ Ensure necessary coordination with the contributing groups (liaison statements to and from contributing working parties to provide in particular the system characteristics and requirements of the incumbent services)
- ⇒ Carry out technical studies (incl. compatibility & sharing studies)
 & develop Working Documents and draft ITU-R Rec. & Reports for consideration by the relevant ITU-R Study Group(s)
- ⇒ Develop possible draft regulatory/technical solutions to satisfy the WRC-23 agenda items and topics for inclusion in the draft CPM Report to be considered at the 2nd session of CPM-23
- ⇒ Finalize the technical studies prior to RA-23


