He works as director of the astronomical observatory at University Sergio Arboleda since 2000. He is a mechanical engineer from the University of America, specialized in Astronomy at the National University of Colombia and Master in Research and Teaching from Sergio Arboleda University. He worked as Co-manager and project manager of the "first Colombian satellite brought into space, called Libertad 1". He represents Sergio Arboleda University at the Colombian Space Commission (CCE). He is an academician of the International Academy of Astronautics - IAA; he's been president of the Association of Astronomers of Colombia (ASASAC), of the Colombian Network Astronomy (RAC) and vice president of the Colombian Association for the Advancement of Science - ACAC-. He has taught at many private and public Colombian universities. He works also as a consultant of astronomical issues, instrumentation, planetariums, and related items to universities, schools and governmental entities. He's been recognized by prestigious publications as divulgator of science in the field of astronomy and space sciences for national and international media.
