- The task force works on certification-relevant requirements about cyber security, data protection and privacy, and over-the-air (OTA) updates
- The first results of the task force's work will be delivered in December 2017 to the WP.29 ITS/AD Informal Group as a guideline

- Sessions held bi-monthly

Current Status

- The task force has finished identifying key risks and threats
- The task force has started to develop 18 mitigations
 - Based on an extended CIA (confidentiality, integrity, availability) approach
 - Reference documents for the mitigations have been identified
- The task force is on target to meet its goals on time
