Rural Broadband Project Broadband Network Development in White Rural Areas of Greece

Objective: To reduce the "broadband gap" in rural areas by covering >85% of population with Class A services at the end of Phase A (2 years)

Scope: Provide wholesale broadband services (bit stream) to retail providers (ISPs).

Investment Model: Public-Private Partnerships




European Agricultural and Rural Development fund 2007 - 2013, 2014 - 2020






Trikala City: The first Greek 5G pilot


The Secretary General of Telecommunications and Post signs MoU with the Mayor of Trikala on implementing a 5G pilot




Trikala Smart City Pilot (smart bins and smart meters
