Industry Goal for Communications Standards / Recommendations

- Deployment at scale of interoperable communication devices
- Communication industry always looking for leveraged Return on Investment on a consistent cadence

- Three dud ITU Recommendations (G.pnt, G.hn, MediaHomeNet)
- Four successful ITU Recommendations (T.30 Annex F, G.handshake, G.adsl, G.vdsl
- Four decades
- Twenty+ communication standards groups
- Eight+ Million miles
- Twenty+ Billion communication devices interoperating from technical contributions

Indicators of Success/Failure

Practicality

- Are there multiple industry participants that actually manufacture/sell products?
- Is the work instigated by an academic institution?
- Are participants from the products division of a company?

Originality

- Is the basis of the work from a known industry standards group?
- Is it a rubber stamp of existing work?
- Does it enhance existing hardware or require replacement?

Ubiquity

- Will the work be deployed in multiple regions?
- Is the work supported by multiple regions?
- Is it desired by regions outside of the originating region?


Singularity

- Is ITU just a different venue to bicker? (venue shopping)(G. Have Nots)
- Does it create more confusion by attempting yet another approach?
- Does it resolve between two existing approaches?

Points to incorporate

- A formal set of tests might be artificially countered.
- Three eras: Voiceband, birth of broadband service, Home Networking
- Home networking
 - In 2004 and 2005 there were many ITU workshops and meeting on Home networking. Industry
 was swirling with technologies, names and approaches
 - One technology "won": Wi-Fi
 - Was the greatest enabler of ITU actually ITU-R WRCs?
