The ICC Story



Pursuant to GA Resolution 2741 (XXV) of 17 Dec 1970, ICC was created as an UN inter-organization facility.



Setup to provide services for mainframe and data communications – using Cost-Recovery Model (not-for-profit)



We still run two mainframe systems!!

Over 50 Clients and nearly 40 service offerings across strategic consulting, emerging technologies, solution development, information security, on premise UN cloud as well as various *aaS cloud solutions.



Digital Trust

> Computation Trust

- What: is the (deep) machine learning system doing with my data?
- <u>How</u>: is the system reaching it's conclusion?



Operational Trust

• <u>Who</u>: is handling my information; beyond the system – human operators? (this starts to intersect with privacy concerns)



Digital Trust: Relational Seq TB Data Platform

Supporting global public health

- > Programme to catalogue genotypic and phenotypic metadata to analyse drug susceptibility testing of 'Mycobacterium tuberculosis'.
- > Under the WHO umbrella, countries are giving data for pipeline processing and subsequent analysis.



Digital Trust & Capacity Building

Example for Country Framework

- Non-health initiative by IPPC/FAO (Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, Rome)
- > IPPC: Effective action to prevent and to control the introduction and spread of pests of plants and plant products
- > Programme to provide least developed and developing nations with capabilities (process and technology) to effectively manage import/export of plant and plant related (phytosanitary) products:
 - Build and train on new digital processes
 - Provide Digital solutions
