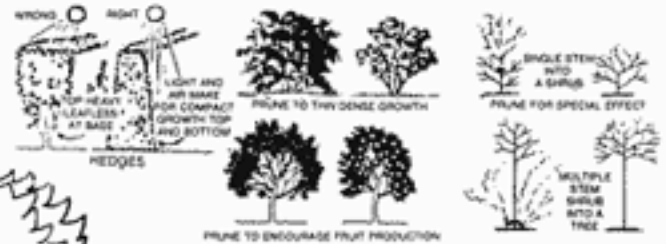
# Constraint and enabler

## HOW TO PRUNE A BRANCH



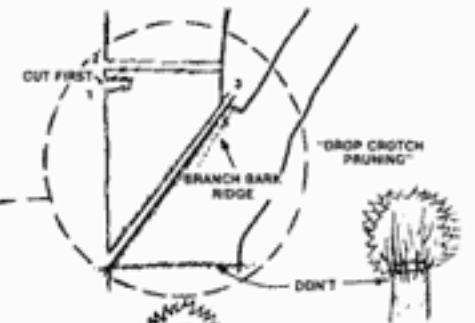
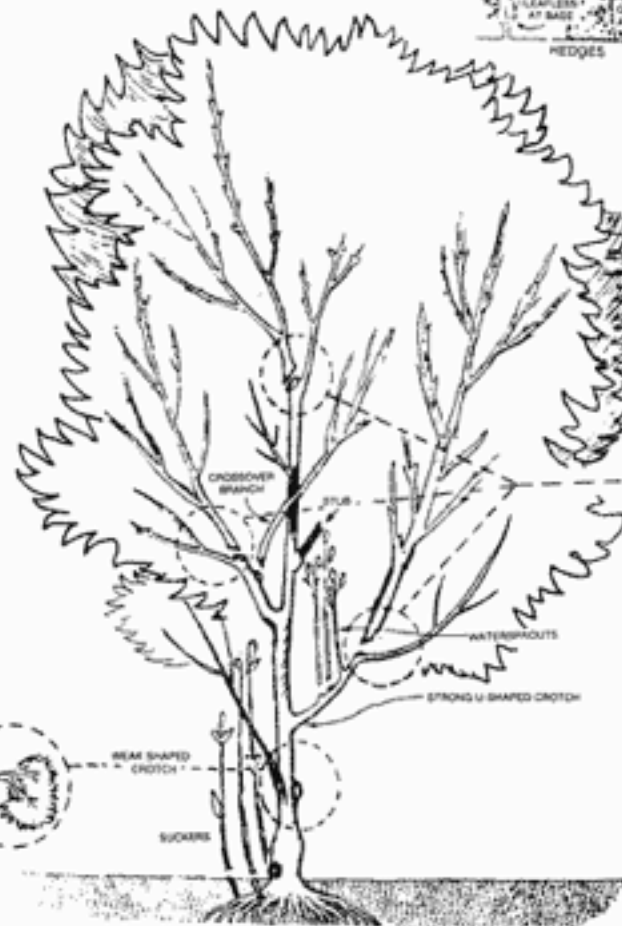
1. Do not leave stubs.

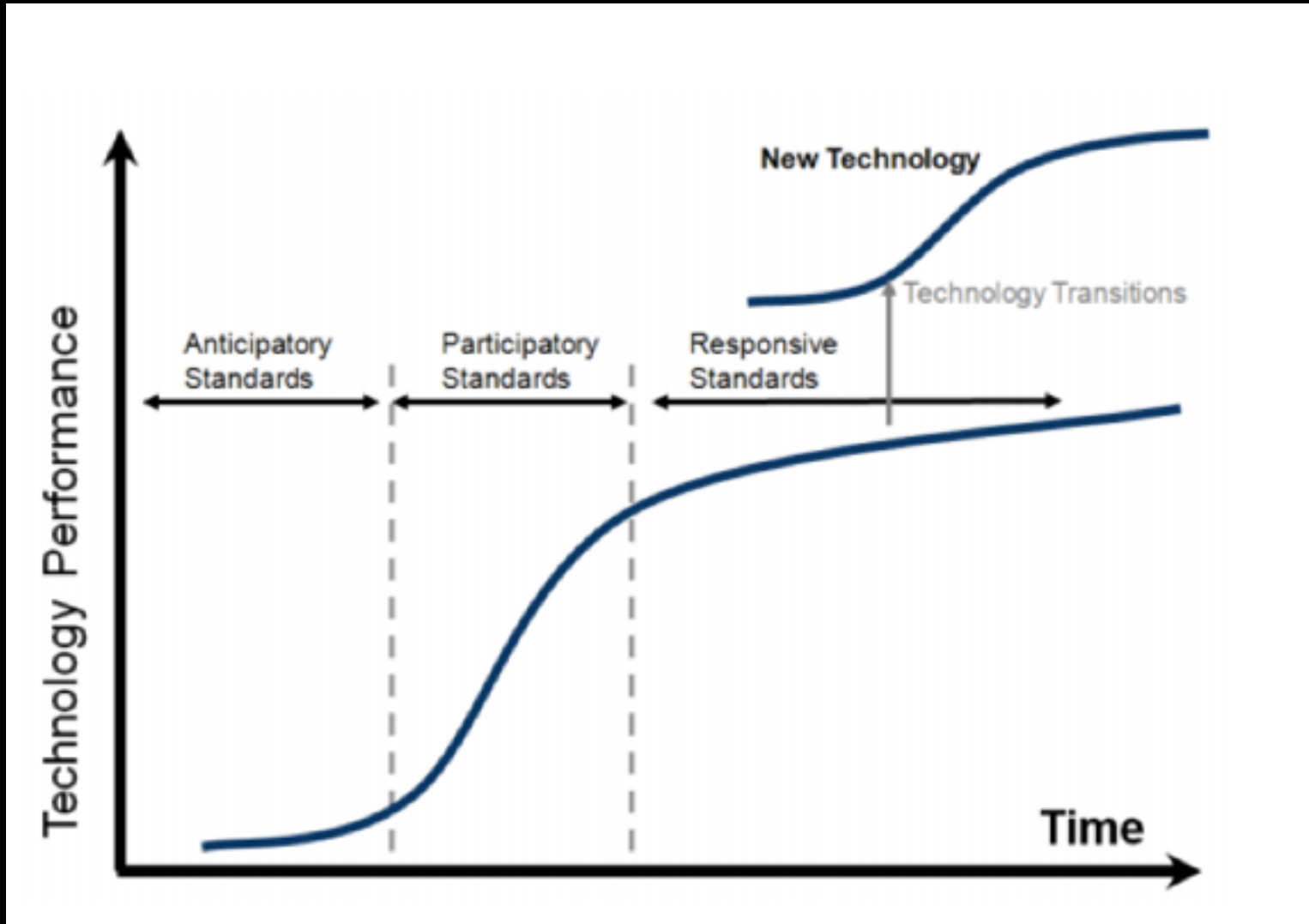

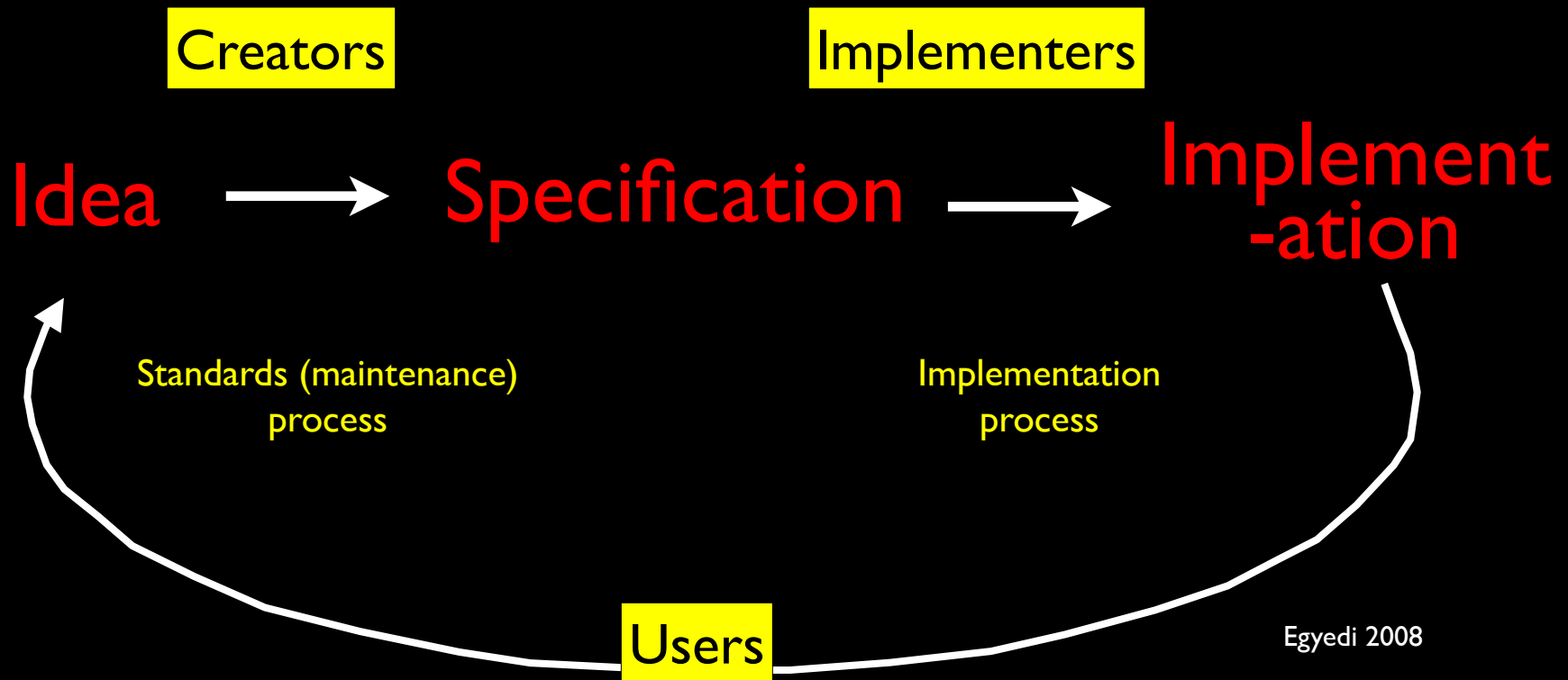

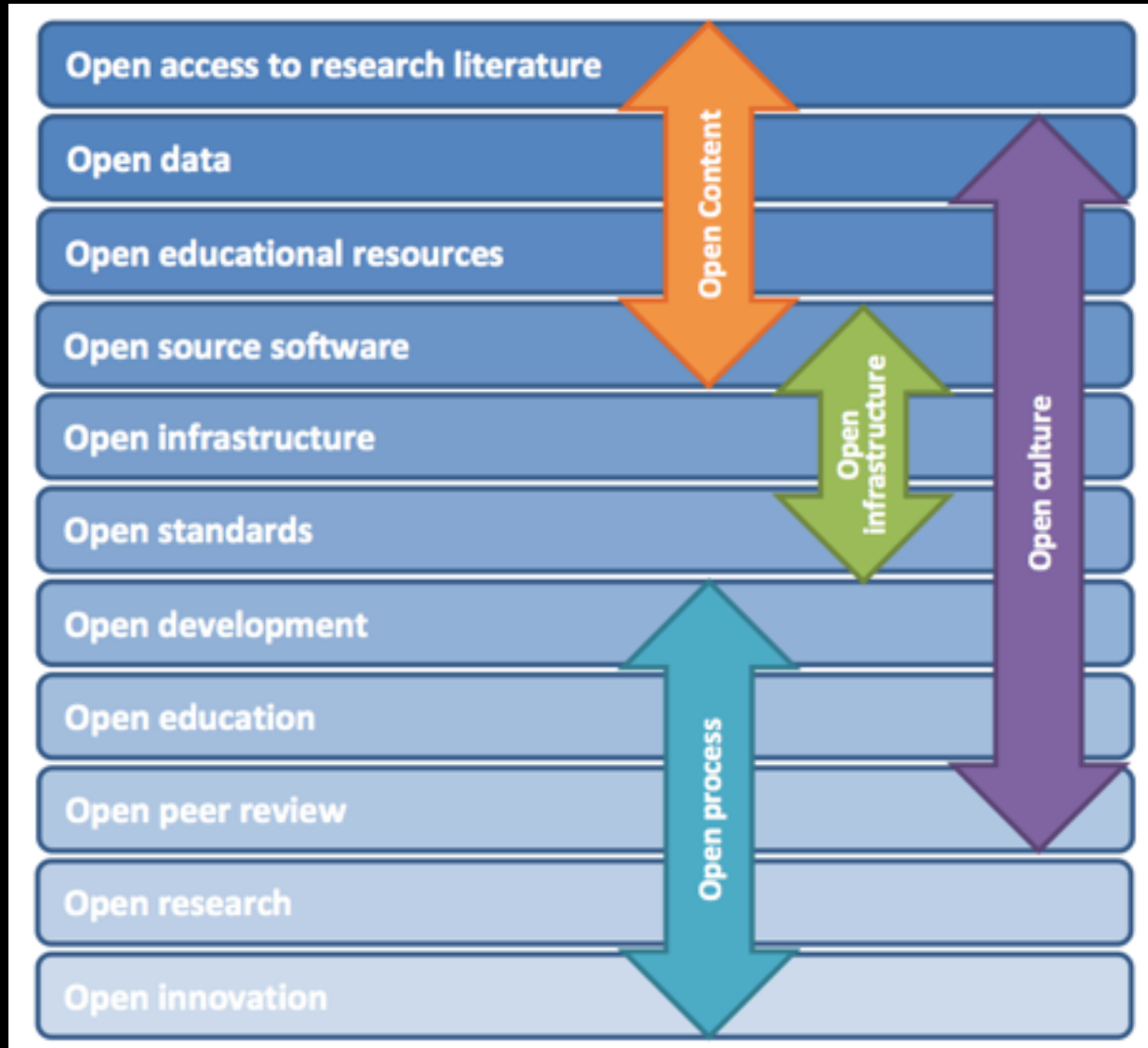
