1 The sixth meeting of the ITU-T Focus Group on *Technologies for Network 2030* (FG NET-2030) is scheduled to take place on 14 and 15 January 2020 in Lisbon, Portugal, under the kind invitation of [Instituto de Telecomunicações](#) (Portugal) and [Instituto Universitário de Lisboa](#) (ISCTE).

2 Participation in FG NET-2030 is open to ITU Member States, Sector Member, Associates and Academia. It is also open to any individual from a country which is a member of ITU and who is willing to contribute to the work. This includes individuals who are also members or representatives of interested standards development organizations.

3 The meeting will open at **0930** on **14 January 2020** at Instituto Universitário de Lisboa (ISCTE) **Avenida das Forças Armadas, 1649-026 Lisbon**. Participants' onsite registration will begin at 08:30 hours. No registration fee is required for participating in this meeting. The discussions will be held in English only.

4 The meeting will be preceded by *the sixth ITU workshop on Network 2030 and Demo Day* to take place on 13 January 2020 at the same location. Participation is open to everybody with no fees.
