- ML: taken up by most study groups
- Focus: ML for future networks incl. 5G
(ML5G: <https://itu.int/en/ITU-T/focusgroups/ml5g>)

ML5G: Phase 1 (2018 – March): (almost) Completed Specs

Done:

- Architecture framework -> ITU-T Rec

To come:

- Use cases and requirements
- Framework for data handling to enable ML
- Method for evaluating mobile network intelligence level

ML5G: Phase 2: now – July 2020

- Identify ML-aided/-enabled networking functionalities, networking and computing entities, interfaces
- Data flow, data management
- Develop data sharing framework for operator-hosted datasets
- Sandbox framework

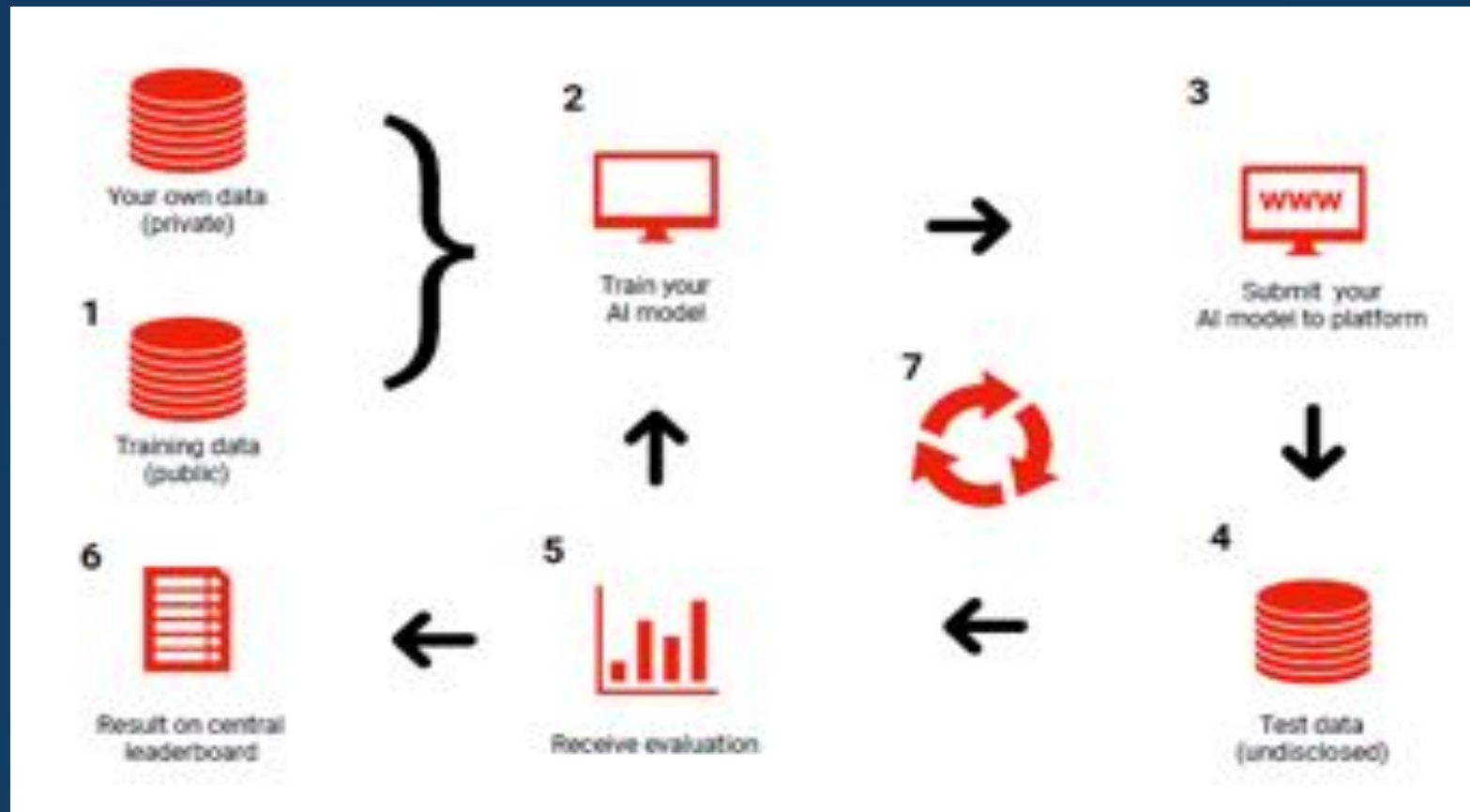

Goal: Developing benchmark framework for testing AI models for health

- Cardiovascular disease risk prediction
- Classifying autism through analysis of brain imagery
- Dermatology
- Falls among the elderly
- Histopathology
- Neuro-cognitive diseases
- Ophthalmology
- Psychiatry
- Snakebite and snake identification
- Symptom assessment
- Tuberculosis
