Organization


- A general incorporated association and non-profit standards development organization (SDO), based in Tokyo, Japan.



IPR Guidelines

- Specify basic principles for handling IPR
- > IPR is defined as "Industry Property Rights".

Treatment

- Selection for Essential IPR:
 - Option 1 (Royalty Free),
 - Option 2 (Reasonable And Non-Discriminatory) or
 - Option 3 (Others) should be selected.
- Inclusion of IPRs in Standards: No responsibility of ARIB
- Dispute regarding IPRs: No liability of ARIB
- Procedure
 - > Submission of "Confirmation Form"
 - Submission date

IPR Documents (2/2)



IPR Working Guidelines

- Essential IPR shall be treated as provided in the IPR Guidelines with no other terms and conditions.
- Treatment of "Non-Essential IPR" is excluded in the IPR Guidelines.
- A potential holder of Essential IPR who is not able to submit a "Confirmation Form" by the submission date can submit a "Comprehensive Confirmation Form".
- The submitter of the "Comprehensive Confirmation Form" should submit the "Confirmation Form" within six months to declare the Essential IPR.



Search

- A) Search by standard number and its version
 - Select the "standard number" and "version number", then click the "Search" button.
 - If you specify version number (2.0, for instance), a list of IPRs declared when making the version (2.0) is displayed.
 - If you select "all" in version column, a list of all IPRs relating to the selected standard is displayed.
- B) Search by free words
 - > Enter your free words in the free words column, then click the "Search" button.
 - > A list of IPRs with the words you entered is displayed.

Copyright Guidelines



- i. The author of the Standard (STD) and the Technical Report (TR), including translation, is ARIB. ARIB can use STD/TR and sublicense them to any third party.
- ii. Members shall acknowledge the above condition in (i) when submitting the material, such as texts and graphics excluding software, to the Standard Assembly. The ownership of copyright shall be retained.
- iii. Non-Members should submit the material on the condition that they agree with provision (i).
- iv. When a quotation from a third party is made regarding the material, the origin should be notified.

- Irrevocability of RF (Royalty Free) or RAND (Reasonable and Non-Discriminatory) Declaration
- > Transfer of IPR Ownership
- > Treatment of Patent Family
- Software Copyright Guidelines and Trademark Guidelines.
