The field of Human-Computer Interaction (HCI) has been extremely successful in the last thirty years, changing computing to the benefit of end users. Advanced mobile, ubiquitous and pervasive computing have dramatically changed the way we interact with information, making human factors an essential part of computer science and informatics in all areas of our daily life.

The venue of SouthCHI 2013 is Maribor, Slovenia, a city located just 40 miles south of Graz, Austria. Maribor is also the European Capital of Culture 2012 and the cultural capital project goes until end of June 2013, so SouthCHI will be the very final celebration during the world famous Lent Festival. SouthCHI is co-organized with IEEE Slovenia and ACM Slovenia.

SouthCHI Papers are publications of original research in all area of Human-Computer Interaction. Authors are invited to submit complete unpublished papers and are not under review in any other conference or journal in the following, but not limited to, topic areas:

- all aspects of Human Factors, Human-Computer Interaction and Usability Engineering and
- Media Communication.

Publication

All submissions will be reviewed by at least three independent reviewers from SouthCHI programme committee and selected reviewers. Accepted contributions will be printed in the Lecture Notes in Computer Science (LNCS) Series published by Springer and indexed in Thomson Reuters Citation Index. Authors of selected papers will be invited to submit an extensively expanded version of their papers to be considered for publication in special issues of international journals, indexed with Science Citation Index. Best paper awards and Best presentation awards

Three best papers and one best PhD work will be selected by an international jury among regular papers presented at SouthCHI 2012.

Three best presentations and one best PhD presentation will also be selected among the session chairs.
