- Decisions on the working methods and structure of ITU-T Study Groups for the next study period
- Elections take place for leadership positions for Study Groups (SGs) and Telecommunication Standardization Advisory Group (TSAG).

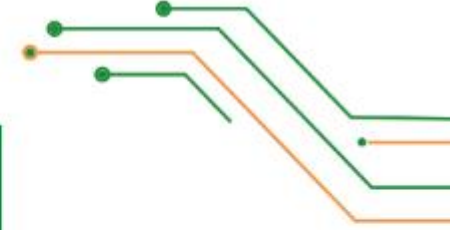

ITU TIES Account Creation

- ITU members can create ITU TIES account through <https://user.itu.int/login> by selecting 'Member State' from the drop down menu.

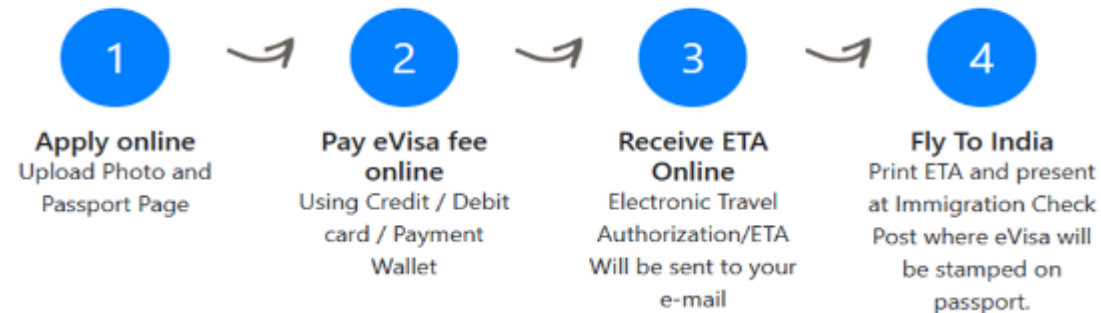
- Other delegates will select membership type as 'Non-Member' from drop down menu and proceed to create ITU User Account.

Confirmation of Registration & Badging

- Acknowledgement of registration request and confirmation of the registration will be sent on email to the delegates.
- Delegates may collect badges at the venue from 11 October 2024 onwards

- **For Applicants with Visa waiver:** India has Visa Exemption Agreement for holders of Diplomatic, Official/Service Passports with several countries (List of countries <https://www.mea.gov.in/bvwa-menu.htm>).
 - Delegates in this category will not require separate visa for attending WTSA .
- **For applicants eligible for e-Visa:** India provides e-Visa for nationals of 173 countries (list at <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/evisa/tvoa.html>)
 - Delegates from these countries can apply online for e-Visa under e-Conference category, pay e-Visa fees and receive Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA) online.
 - e-Visa will be stamped on presenting ETA at the Immigration Counter on arrival at Delhi.

E-VISA APPLICATION PROCESS



- **For applicants not covered under above two categories**

Nationals of these countries will be required to apply for Visa by submitting Visa applications through the respective Indian Embassy/Consulates after registration for WTSA.

- **For holders of United Nations laissez-passer (UNLP)**

These delegates may submit Visa application at the respective consulate

1. **Immigration Counter:** Dedicated Immigration Counters for WTSA delegates to ensure smooth visa & immigration processes for the delegates.

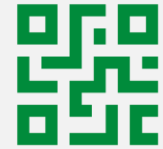
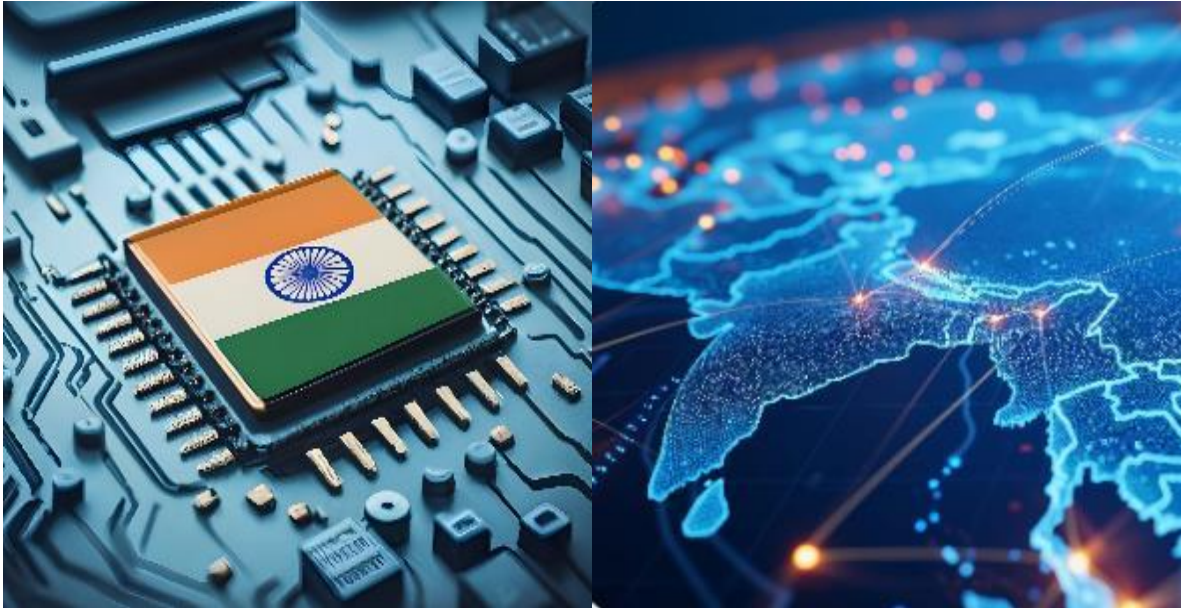

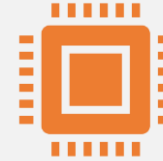
