1. to make all the necessary arrangements, in agreement with the Director of the Radiocommunication Bureau, for the convening of the Conference;
2. to communicate this resolution to international and regional organizations concerned.

R 1180 Consultation of Member States on the Planning of Terrestrial Broadcasting in the VHF and UHF Bands

The Council,

considering

- a) that, following the result of the consultation of the Member States of the European Broadcasting Area to convene a Regional Radiocommunication Conference to revise the Regional Agreement for the European Broadcasting Area (Stockholm, 1961), hereinafter referred to as the Stockholm 1961 Agreement, it adopted, at its 2001 session, Resolution 1185 relating to the Regional Radiocommunication Conference to revise the Stockholm 1961 Agreement;
- b) that at its 2001 session Member States, pertaining to the planning area of the Regional Agreement Relating to the Planning of VHF/UHF Television Broadcasting in the African Broadcasting Area and Neighbouring Countries, Geneva 1989, hereinafter referred to as the Geneva 1989 Agreement¹, expressed the wish to convene a Regional Radiocommunication Conference to revise the Geneva 1989 Agreement for the same purposes as those of Resolution 1185 and to combine it with the conference referred to in Resolution 1185;
- c) that, during the same session of the Council, several Member States expressed the wish to extend the planning area to countries not covered or only partially covered by the Agreements referred to in *considerings* a and b above,

noting

- a) that the combination of the planning areas of the Stockholm 1961 and the Geneva 1989 Agreements is not subject to the application of Resolution 7 (Kyoto, 1994);
- b) that, from a technical as well as economical viewpoint, it will be beneficial to all Member States belonging to the combined planning area to undertake the planning process simultaneously,

fully aware of

- a) provisions 301 to 305 of the Convention, according to which the convening of a Regional Radiocommunication Conference for the revision of the Geneva 1989 Agreement is subject to a positive reply by the majority of the Member States pertaining to the planning area of the Geneva 1989 Agreement following consultation by the Secretary-General;
- b) that Resolution 7 (Kyoto, 1994) entrusts the Council to propose to the Member States concerned a definition of a region when it becomes necessary for the purpose of convening a regional radiocommunication conference;
- c) that the Resolution referred to above specifies that the region proposed by the Council for a regional radiocommunication conference shall be deemed to have been defined when two thirds of the Member States consulted have responded in the affirmative,

resolves

1. to propose, in application of provisions 301 to 305 of the Convention, the convening of a Regional Radiocommunication Conference to revise the Geneva 1989 Agreement with the same agenda, venue and duration as the conference referred to in Resolution 1185;
2. to propose to the Member States of the European Broadcasting Area and to the Member States pertaining to the planning area of the Geneva 1989 Agreement a merging of the Regional Radiocommunication Conferences to revise the Stockholm 1961 Agreement and the Geneva 1989 Agreement that may result from the application of *resolves* 1 above;
3. to propose, in application of Resolution 7 (Kyoto, 1994), the extension of the planning area, i.e. as applicable the planning area of the Stockholm 1961 Agreement or the planning area of the Geneva 1989 Agreement or the combination of the planning areas of these two Agreements, to the countries that are not or only partially covered, and listed in *instructs the Secretary-General*, as applicable;
4. that the time period referred to in *resolves* 3 of Resolution 7 (Kyoto, 1994) shall be 8 weeks,

instructs the Secretary-General

as a matter of urgency

1. to consult the Member States pertaining to the planning area of the Geneva 1989 Agreement to seek their agreement for convening a Regional Radiocommunication Conference for the revision of the Geneva 1989 Agreement with the agenda, venue and duration as the conference referred to in Resolution 1185;
2. simultaneously with the consultation referred to in *resolves* 1 above, to consult the Member States of the European Broadcasting Area and the Member States pertaining to the planning area of the Geneva 1989 Agreement, to seek their agreement for the holding of a Regional Radiocommunication Conference with the same agenda, dates and venue as the conference referred to in Resolution 1185, for the purpose of developing an Agreement and Associated Plan covering both the planning area of the Stockholm 1961 Agreement and that of the Geneva 1989 Agreement;
3. subsequently with a view to cover the wishes expressed for the extension of the planning area and depending on the result of the consultations referred to in *instructs the Secretary-General* 1 and 2:

3.1 if the replies to both the consultations under *instructs the Secretary-General* 1 and 2 above yield the majorities required, as referred to in No. 47 of the Convention, to consult, in application of Resolution 7 (Kyoto, 1994) and taking account of *resolves* 4 above, the Member States of the planning area resulting from *instructs the Secretary-General* 2 above and the countries listed below to seek their agreement on the extension of the planning area to cover the following countries that are not or only partially covered:

Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Kazakstan, Kyrgyzstan, Russian Federation (the part of the territory to the west from longitude 170° E), Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan

and simultaneously with the above consultation to consult the Member States indicated above to seek their agreement on the convening of a Regional Radiocommunication Conference for the extended planning area with the same agenda, dates and venue as the conference referred to in Resolution 1185,

or

3.2 if the replies to the consultation do not yield the majority required, as referred to in No. 47 of the Convention, under *instructs the Secretary-General* 2 above, to consult separately, in application of Resolution 7 (Kyoto 1994) and taking account of *resolves* 4 above:

a) on the one hand the Member States of the European Broadcasting Area and the countries indicated below to seek their agreement on the extension of the planning area of the Regional Radiocommunication Conference to cover the following countries that are not or only partially covered:

Algeria (territory outside EBA), Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Kazakstan, Kyrgyzstan, Libya (territory outside EBA), Morocco (territory outside EBA), Russian Federation (the part of the territory to the west from longitude 170° E), Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, Spain (territory outside EBA)

and simultaneously with the above consultation to consult the Member States indicated above to seek their agreement on the convening of a Regional Radiocommunication Conference for the extended planning area with the same agenda, dates and venue as the conference referred to in Resolution 1185,

and

b) on the other hand, if the majority required, as referred to in No. 47 of the Convention, under *instructs the Secretary-General* 1 above is obtained, the Member States, pertaining to the planning area of the Geneva 1989 Agreement, and the countries indicated below to seek their agreement on the extension of the planning area of the Regional Radiocommunication Conference for the extended planning area to cover the following countries that are not or only partially covered:

and simultaneously with the above consultation to consult the Member States indicated above to seek their agreement on the convening of a Regional Radiocommunication Conference for the extended planning area with the same agenda, dates and venue as the conference referred to in Resolution 1185,

resolves further

1. if the replies to the consultations yield the majority required, as referred to in No. 47 of the Convention, under *instructs the Secretary-General* 1 and 2 above but not that required under *instructs the Secretary-General* 3.1 above, the planning area of Resolution 1185 shall be replaced by the planning areas of both the Stockholm 1961 and Geneva 1989 Agreements;

2. if the replies to the consultation under *instructs the Secretary-General* 3.1 yield the majority required as referred to in No. 47 of the Convention, the planning area of Resolution 1185 shall be replaced by the planning areas of both the Stockholm 1961 and Geneva 1989 Agreements and the following countries that are not or only partially covered:

Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Kazakstan, Kyrgyzstan, Russian Federation (the part of the territory to the west from longitude 170° E), Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan

3. if the replies to the consultations under

a) *instructs the Secretary-General* 3.2a yield the majority required as referred to in *resolves* 3 of Resolution 7 (Kyoto, 1994), a Conference will be convened for the European Broadcasting Area and the countries indicated below with the agenda as contained in Resolution 1185:

Algeria (territory outside EBA), Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Kazakstan, Kyrgyzstan, Libya (territory outside EBA), Morocco (territory outside EBA), Russian Federation (the part of the territory to the west from longitude 170° E), Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, Spain (territory outside EBA)

b) *instructs the Secretary-General* 3.2b yield the majority required as referred to in *resolves* 3 of Resolution 7 (Kyoto, 1994), a Conference will be convened for the planning area of the Geneva 1989 Agreement and the countries indicated below with the agenda as contained in Resolution 1185:
