These MS Word documents include the drawings, images, equations and tables. They are the originals used to make the printed version with all the page make-up and formatting information.

An index to the Recommendations called ReIndex.htm can be used to navigate and locate Recommendations using the Netscape browser or MS Internet Explorer. In some browsers, you need to associate the .DOC file extension to the MS Word programme and the .ZIP file extension to Winzip or other decompression software in order for it to work properly.

Read the README.TXT for the last-minute information about the current issue of the product. It also contains ample explanations on the product.

### Installation of the MS Word viewer and Winzip for Windows

For your convenience, this CD-ROM includes the MS Word viewer and Winzip to be used on MS Windows 3.1, 95, 98, NT, 2000 or XP.

- Insert the CD-ROM labelled "ITU-T Recommendations – Originals (Word)" in the CD-ROM drive.

#### For Windows 3.1 users:

- To install the MS Word viewer, using Notepad, read and follow the instructions of  
\\Utils\Wordview.6\Install.txt
- To install Winzip using File Manager, run this file:  
\\Utils\Winzip\Winzip31.exe

#### For Windows 95, 98, NT, 2000 or XP users:

- To install the MS Word viewer, using Notepad, read and follow the instructions of  
\\Utils\Wordview.7\Install.txt
- To install Winzip using File Manager or Explorer, run this file:  
\\Utils\Winzip\Winzip95.exe

The ITU-T Recommendations developed by the ITU Telecommunication Standardization Sector constitute the basis for international telecommunication standards. They are based on studies of technical, operating and tariff questions and serve to standardize telecommunications on a worldwide basis.

The **ITU-T Recommendations on CD-ROM** keep you in touch with the fast-moving and complex world of telecommunication standards. They are an essential reference for public and private telecommunication operating agencies, manufacturers, government agencies, scientific, industrial and international organizations, consultants, technical colleges and universities, etc.

These CD-ROMs contain ITU-T Recommendations in force. Some Recommendations, not yet available, are included in their pre-published format (Winword). Associated software programmes are in general on the CD-ROMs, unless their volume prevents it, in which case they should be bought separately.

A completely new edition of the CD-ROM replaces the earlier versions every three months.

## Using the Adobe Acrobat PDF collection (Discs 1 and 2)

### Getting started

#### Windows 9x/NT/2000/and XP users

When you insert Discs 1 or 2 of the ITU-T Recommendations CD-ROM into your CD reader, the *Menu* opens automatically provided you have not de-activated the *Autostart* option.

If nothing happens after the insertion of the CD-ROM:

- open Microsoft Windows Explorer™ or an equivalent program;
- select the CD-ROM drive;
- double click “StartCD.bat”; or
- double click “Menu.pdf” located at the root level of the CD-ROM. If Acrobat is not installed on your computer, first install Acrobat Reader found under the \UTILS\Acrobat directory.

From the Menu, you can start navigating into the Series by clicking on the buttons and/or by using the *Search* function in order to find specific information in the ITU-T Recommendations.

#### Installing Acrobat Reader

Install Adobe Acrobat Reader with *Search* on your machine. For your convenience, the Setup program for Acrobat Readers can be found under the \UTILS\Acrobat directory. Once you have installed Acrobat Reader with *Search*, run and open the file called \Menu.pdf
