- World Wide Alliance of 242 Country Code Top Level Domain Registries
- Non-Profit organization with secretariat first established in July 2000
- No membership fee required
- Funding from donation and sponsors
- Small secretariat based in Bangkok
- Consensus decision come from online voting of 242 countries recorded in IANA database

Permanent Secretariat

- Eric Akumiah from Ghana has been employed and trained for AFTLD
