- AFNIC was created on the 1st of January, 1998 as a non-for-profit association
- AFNIC took over the activities of NIC France, a department of the National Institute for Research in Computer Science (INRIA)

Activities & Assignments

- Definition and implementation of the naming policy in compliance with the french laws
- Operational management of the DNS service
- Knowledge transfer, training, coordination, information

Members of the Association 4 categories including public and private sectors

- Founding members
 - Government represented by 3 Ministries: Telecommunications,
 Industry and Research
 - National Institute for Research in Computer Science (INRIA)
- Internet Service Providers about 1000 ISPs including foreign companies
- Internet Users french legal entities and individuals
- International College: international organizations
 - Any legal entity or physical person can become a member of AFNIC -

AFNIC International College

- 30 members including 13 NICs
 - Albania, Algeria, Cameroun, Guinea, Haiti, Ivory Coast,
 Madagascar, Mauritania, Morocco, Niger, Senegal, Tchad, Tunisia
- 1 elected representative and member of the Board of Directors
 - Ahmedou Ould HAOUBA, Dean of the Faculty of Sciences and Technology, University of Nouakchott, and Director of the Mauritanian NIC
- Partnerships and financial support
 - UNESCO, French Foreign Office, INTIF, ...

International College actions - 1

- Trainer's training/FFTI: ten trainings since its creation
 - Two levels :
 - FFTI1 for general network management knowledge
 - FFTI2 for advanced notions: IPv6, DNSsec, PKI etc.
 - 3 regional trainings this year : Morocco, Guinea, Mexico
- Generical NIC: technological transfer + one week training to get global technical knowledge of NIC management.
- Interactive tools: CDrom, and online training

International College actions - 2

- Support to ccTLD management and to administrative procedures to get back ccTLD extension
 - technical support
 - sensibilisation of local authorities
 - creation of a local internet community cooperation
