The meeting of Study Group 2 in September 2002 approved the programme of work concerning a study on access network in developing countries for e-health applications. It is not rare that hospitals are also located far away from the telephone exchange. The questionnaire will help to collect the appropriate information, in order to analyze the current situation and provide the necessary recommendations.
