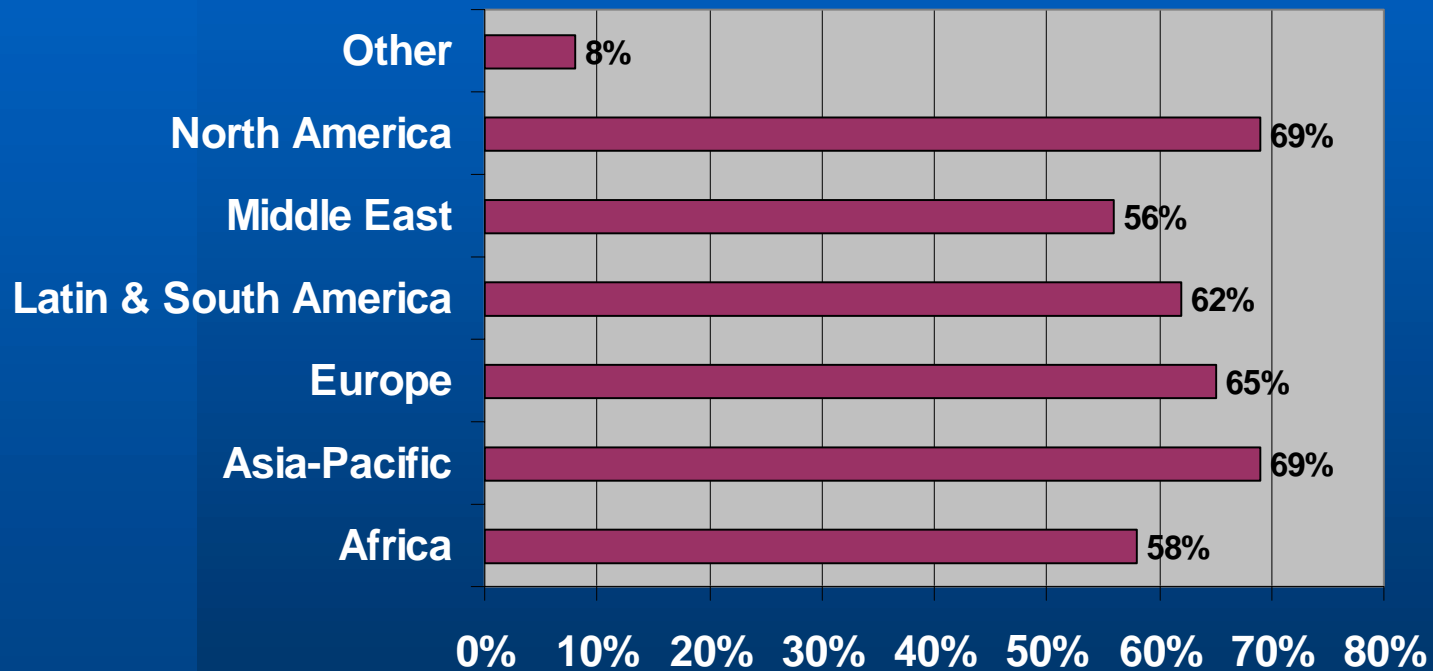

Survey Details

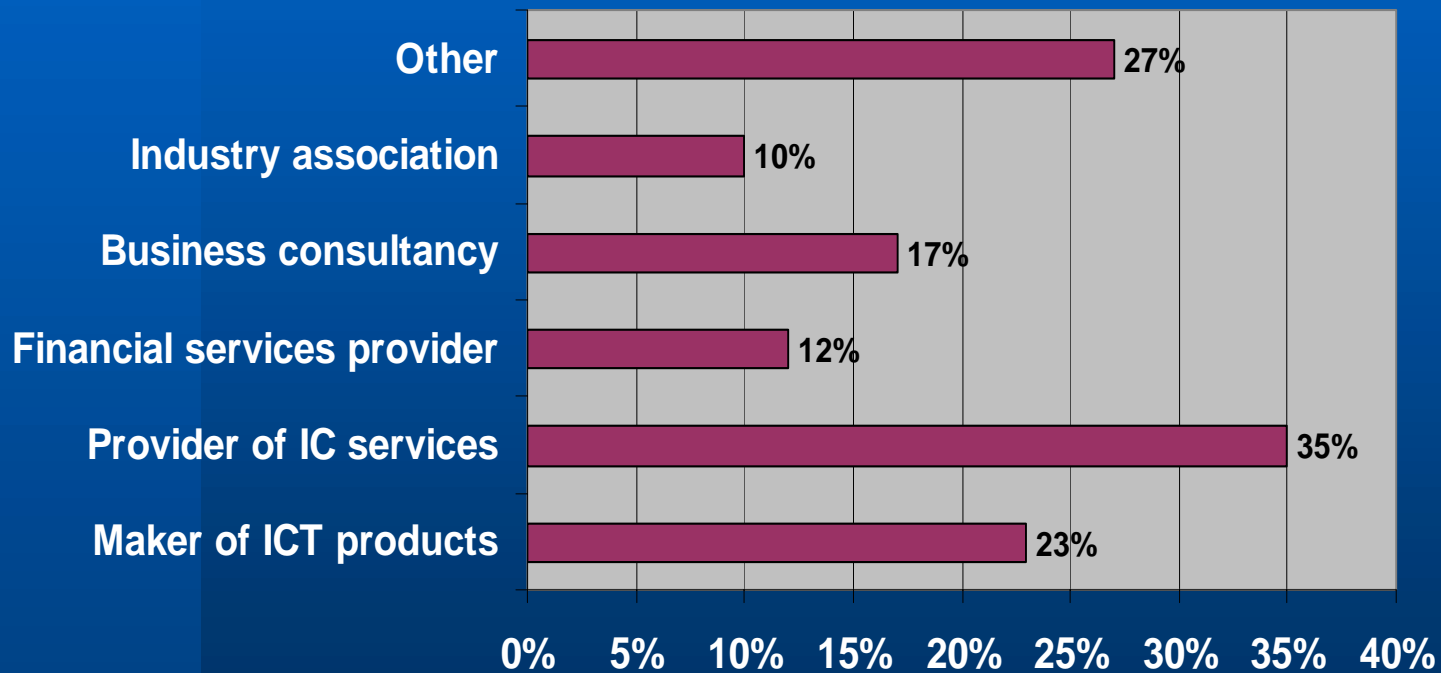
- **Solicited views of 125 executives on August 27**
 - www.giic.org/survey
 - GIIC commissioners, CCBI principals
 - 55 percent response rate
- **Extend to October 21**
 - Input from business leaders in ITU delegation nations

Survey Respondents—Geography



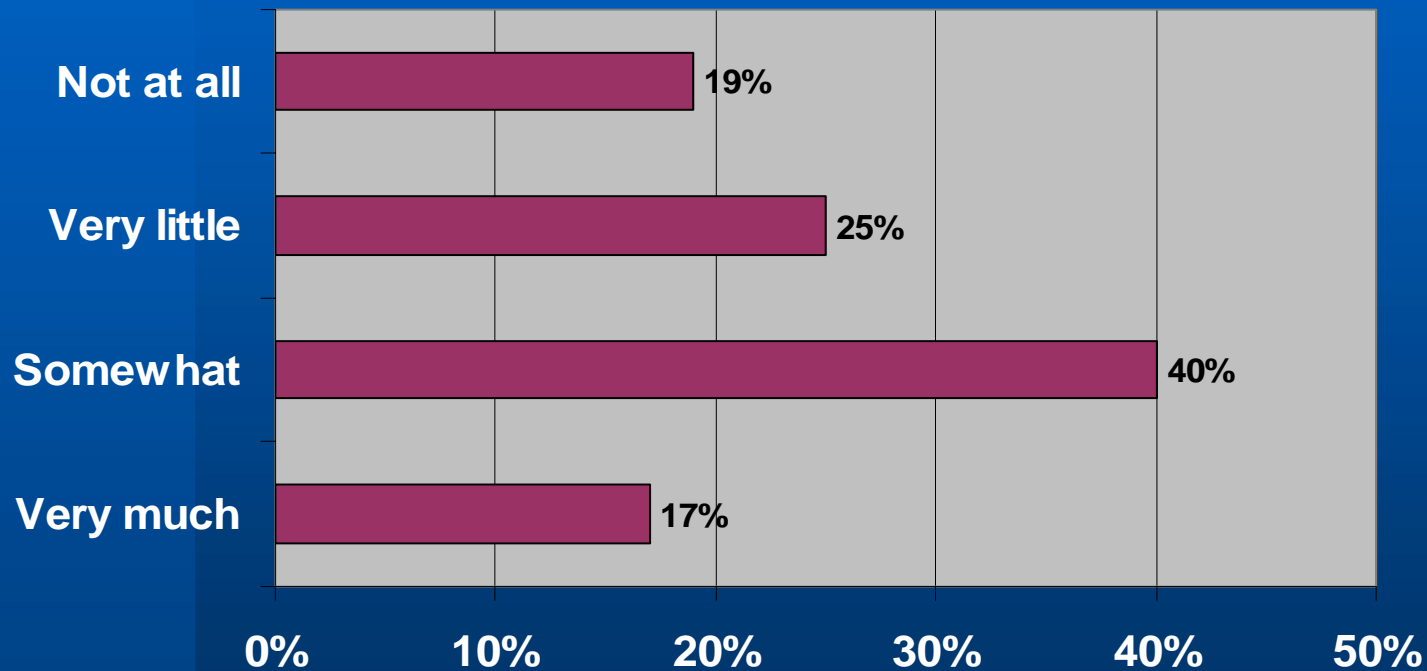
In which regions of the world does your organization conduct business?

Survey Respondents—Businesses



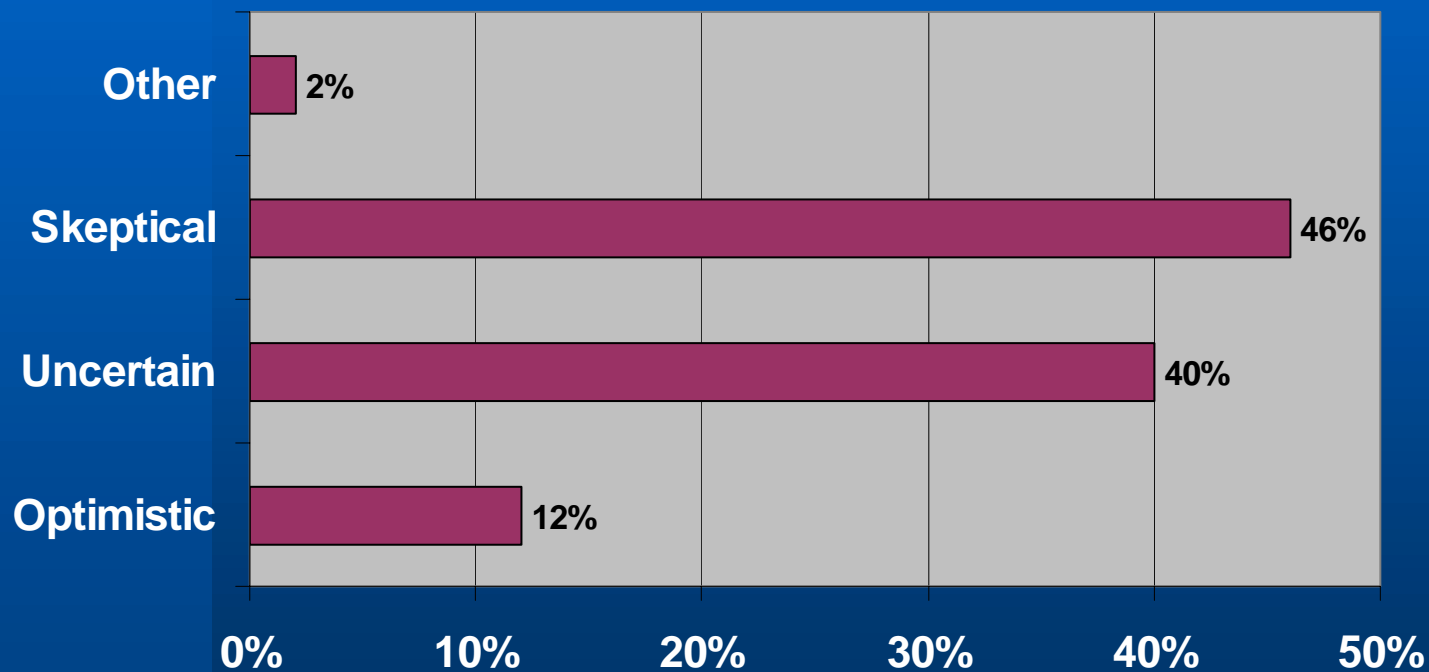
How would you characterize your organization?

WSIS Awareness



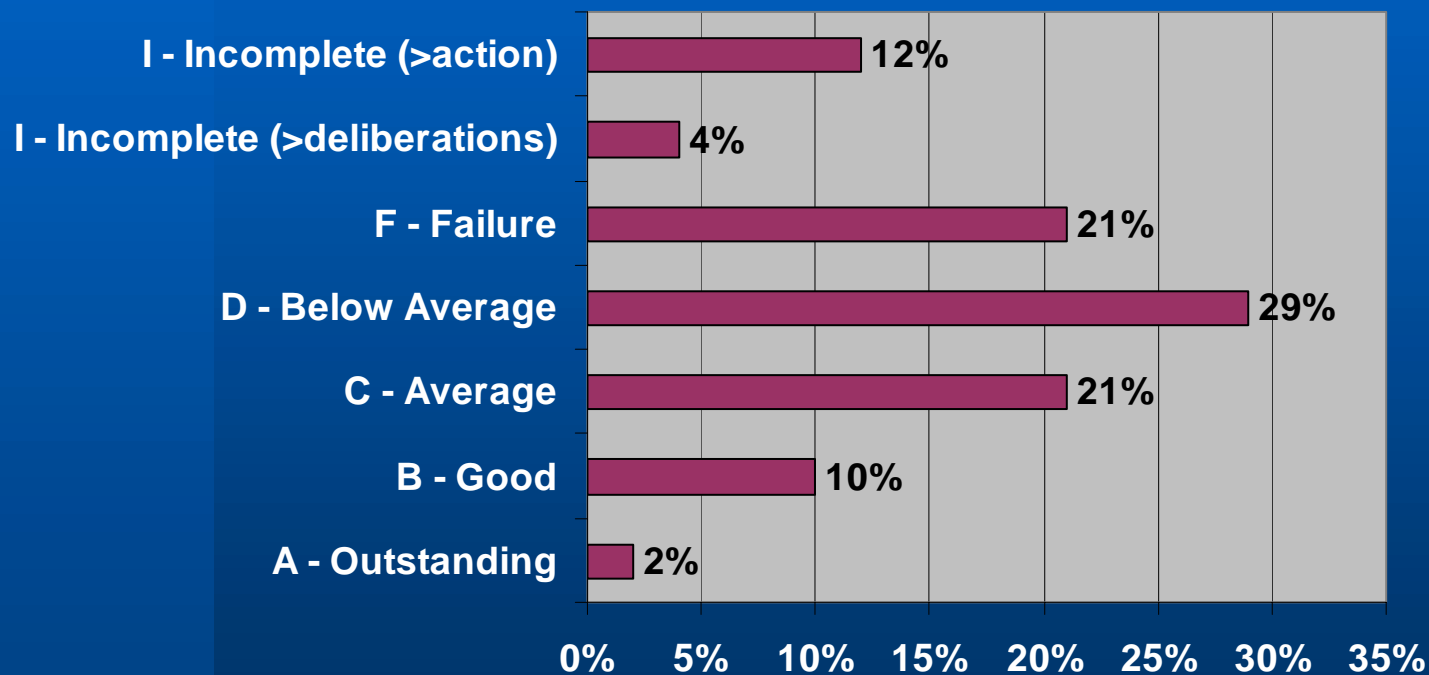
How aware of the World Summit on the Information Society are you?

WSIS Expectations



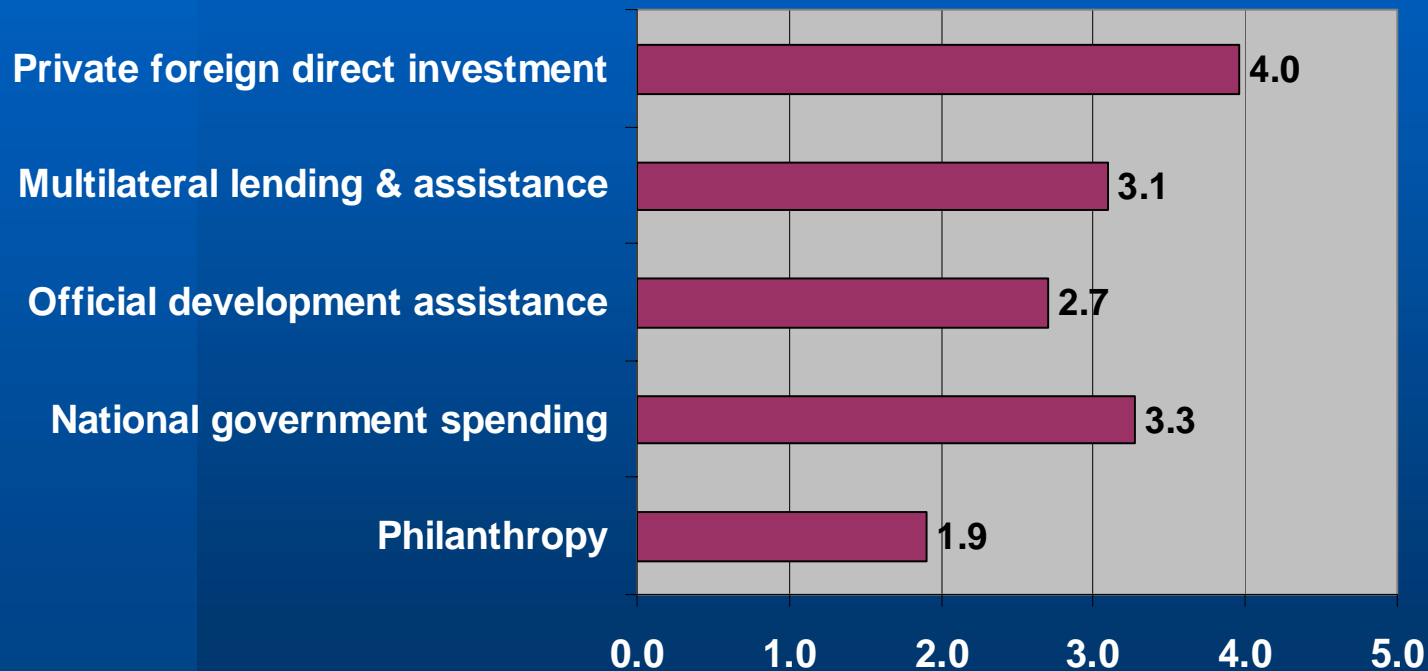
What are your expectations about the usefulness of the Summit?

'Digital Divide' Efforts



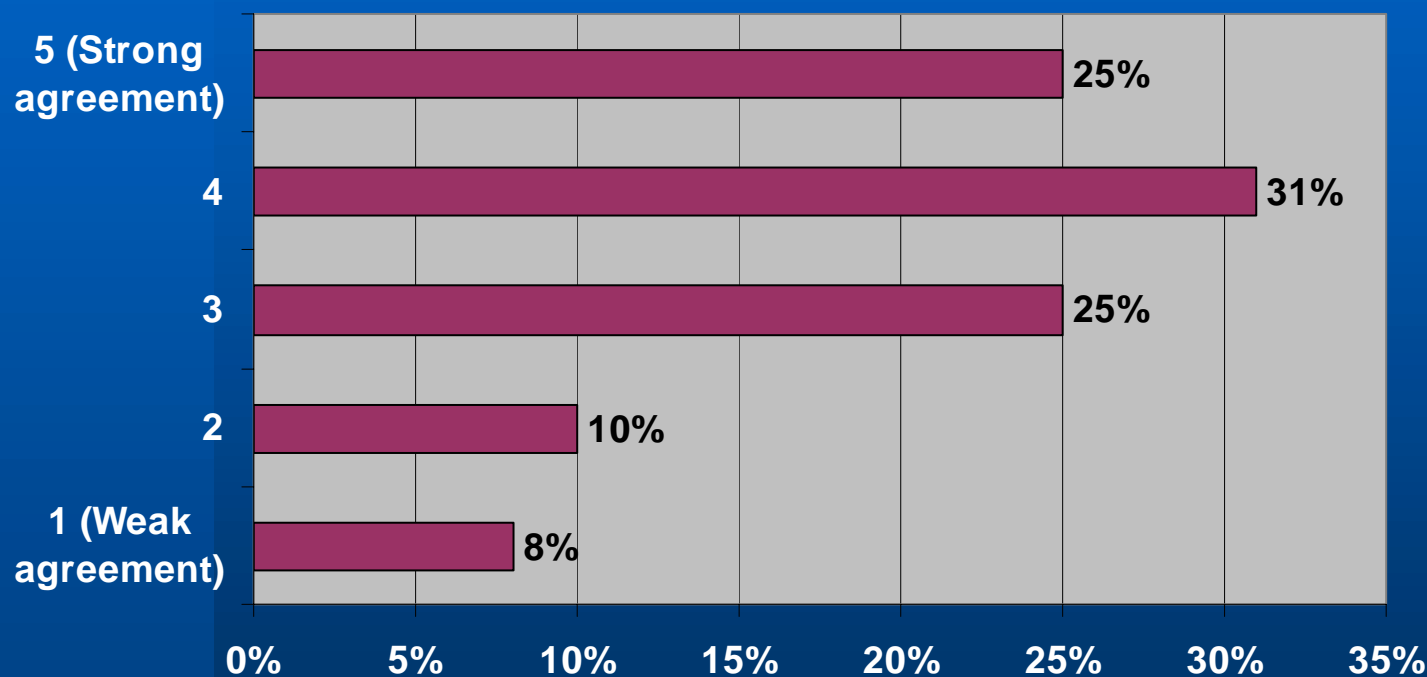
How would you 'grade' intergovernmental and institutional attempts to remedy the international 'digital divide?'

Speediest Funding Sources



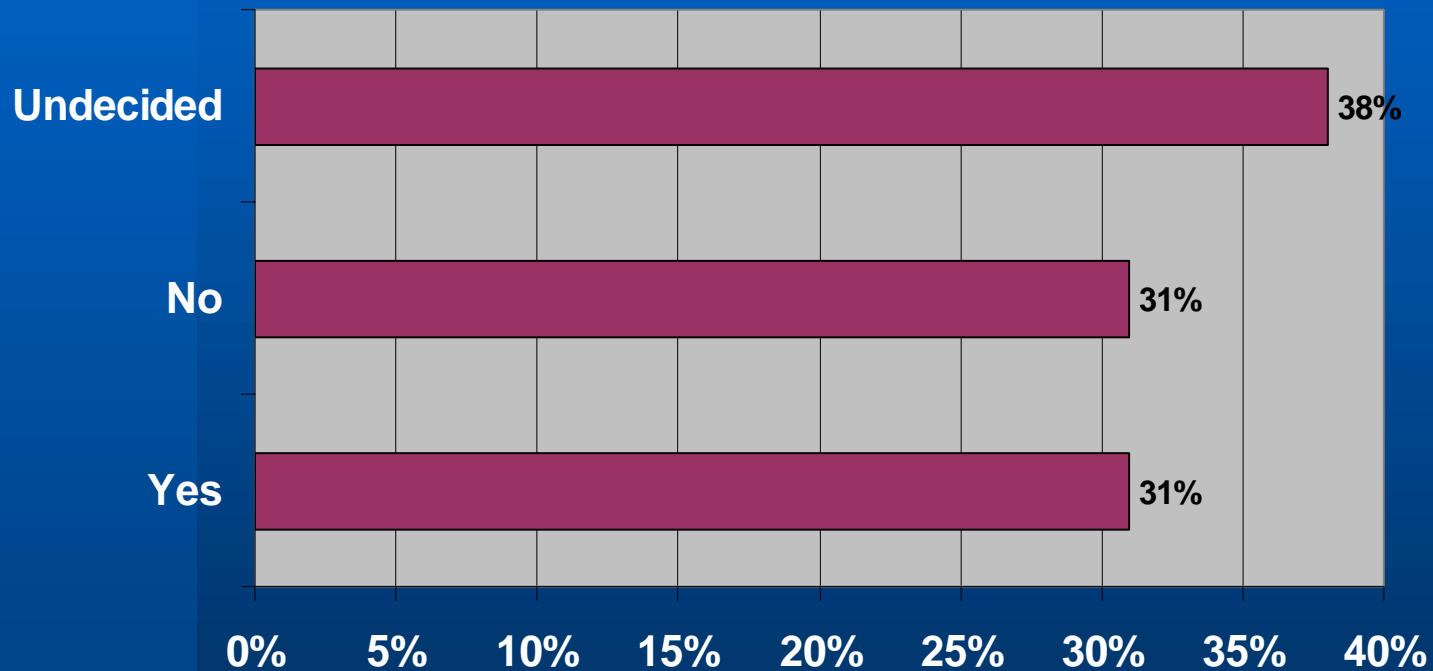
What funding sources do you regard as being most likely to speed evolution toward an Information Society?

WSIS: Private Sector Engagement



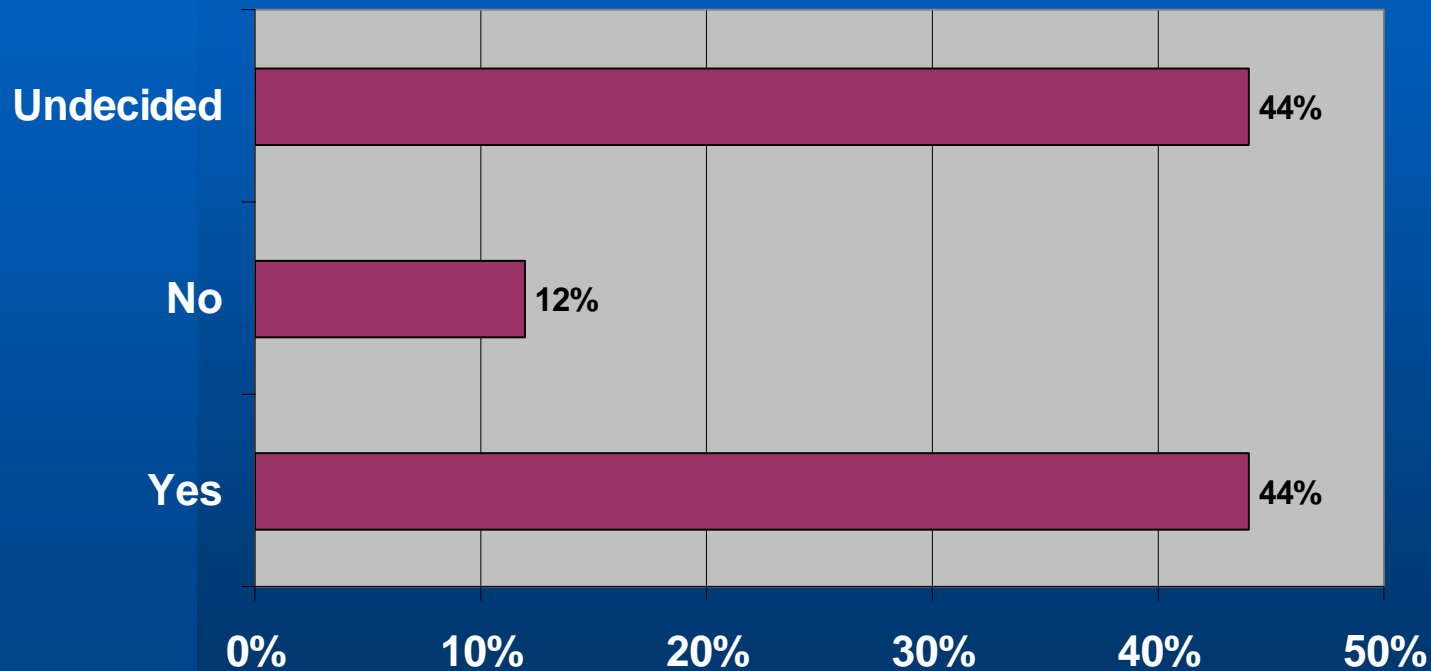
How strongly do you believe the private sector should be engaged in trying to influence the outcome of Summit deliberations?

WSIS: Private Sector Involvement



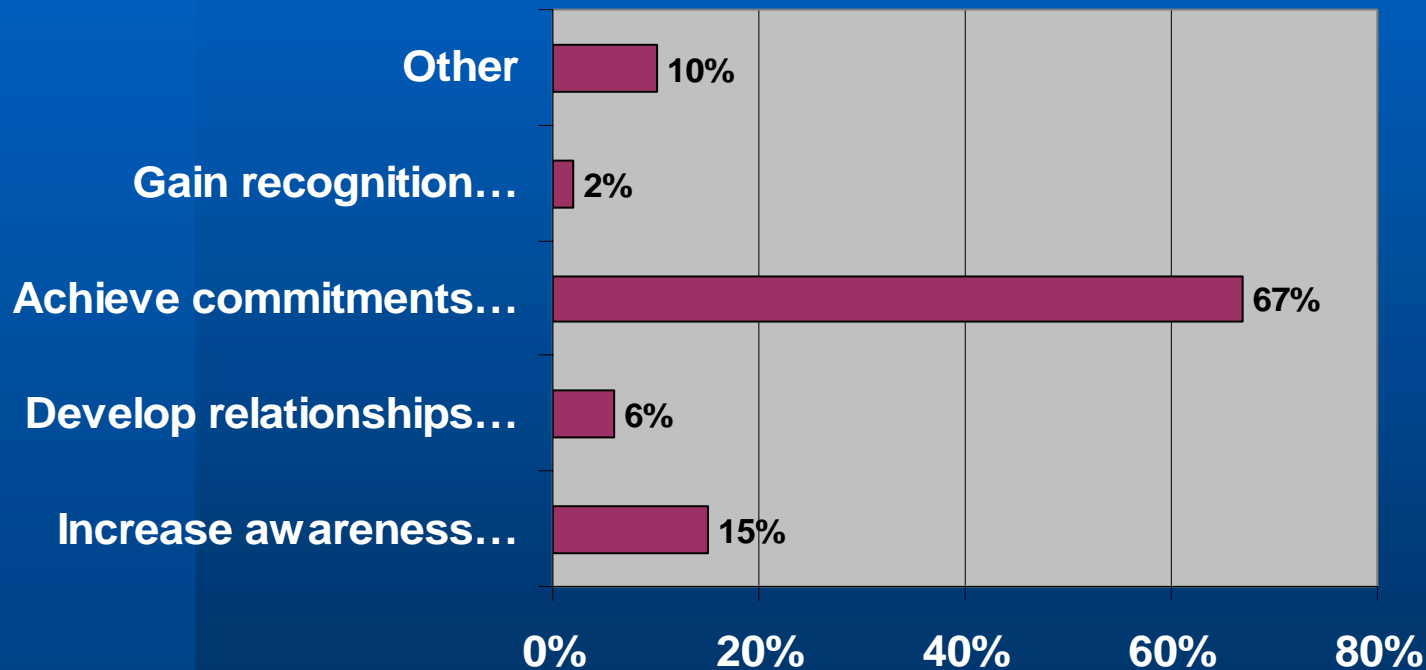
Do you expect to participate in the Summit in Geneva, Tunis, or any of the regional or other preparatory meetings?

	Finding a shared understanding of digital divide	19%
➔	Infrastructure: financing and deployment	69%
➔	Barriers to achievement of information society	46%
	Governance	23%
	Education, HR development, and training	35%
➔	Access to ICTs	44%
	Information security	23%
➔	Development of policy & regulatory framework	50%
	ICT applications	38%

1. Low awareness of Summit
2. Minimal expectations of Summit
3. Diminishing interest in, regard for 'digital divide' efforts
4. FDI is key to funding information society
5. Involvement in Summit process is important
6. Willingness to advocate Summit positions is strong
7. Objective: Achievement of policy commitments
8. Themes:
 - 1 — Infrastructure deployment & financing
 - 2 — Policy & regulatory framework
 - 3 — Barriers to achievement of information society
 - 4 — Access to ICTs
