It is my pleasure to invite your organization/entity to the second meeting of the Preparatory Committee (PrepCom-2) of the Tunis Phase of the World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS), to be held at the Palais des Nations in **Geneva**, from 17 to 25 February 2005.

Second Meeting of the Preparatory Committee of the Tunis Phase of the World Summit on the Information Society
Geneva, 17-25 February 2005

Since PrepCom-1 of the Tunis Phase in June 2004, substantial progress has been made to advance the preparatory process, based on the decisions of that meeting. The Task Force on Financial Mechanisms, which was set up in October 2004, held two meetings to prepare a report to the Secretary-General of the United Nations. This report should be available early next year. The WSIS Stocktaking exercise was launched by the WSIS Executive Secretariat in October 2004, and more than 300 entries have been received to date (<a href="http://www.itu.int/wsis/stocktaking">http://www.itu.int/wsis/stocktaking</a>). The Working Group on Internet Governance, at its first meeting in November 2004, set out timelines for activities and discussed the outline of the report.

Taking account of these achievements, including the report of the Task Force on Financial Mechanisms in particular, PrepCom-2 will begin considering the final outcome to be adopted by the Heads of State and Government at the Tunis Summit. A basic document for negotiation is being prepared by the Group of Friends of the Chair, led by the President of the PrepCom, Ambassador Janis Karklins. The Group will meet in January 2005 in Geneva to finalize the basic document.

PrepCom-2 is intended to achieve consensus on the structure and content of the final document(s), with the exception of matters relating to Internet governance, which will be dealt with at PrepCom-3. PrepCom-2 will also consider the agenda and organization of work of the Tunis Summit.

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For your convenience, all documents for this meeting will soon be posted on the WSIS website (http://www.itu.int/wsis/preparatory2/pc2/).

Electronic registration will be used for PrepCom-2, as was done for the Summit in Geneva. Details can be found in the annex ("Registration and Badging for PrepCom-2").

I look forward to seeing you at this important event in February 2005.

### Registration
