### **Proposal for changes and amendments**

Para 4, 7<sup>th</sup> line:

“...; recognize the role of a free and editorially independent media;...”

(end of para 4)

“We also reaffirm that democracy, sustainable development, respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms as well as good governance at all levels are interdependent and mutually reinforcing.”

[WSIS DOP para 3]

Para 7 – alternative

“We also recognize that the ICT revolution can have a tremendous positive impact as an instrument for social and economic development, given the existence of an enabling environment where good governance, sustainable development, fair distribution and gender equality are important principles.”

New para 10 bis

“We recognize that the threat we face from transnational organized crime is a menace to States and societies, eroding human security and the fundamental obligation of States to provide for law and order. In this respect, a global culture of cyber-security needs to be promoted, developed and implemented in cooperation with all stakeholders and international expert bodies”
