The World Telecommunications Development Conference which was held in Hyderabad, India in 2010 (WTDC-2010), identified natural disasters as a major threat to socio-economic development and adopted emergency telecommunications as one of the regional initiatives for almost all the regions including the Americas. In that regard, the International Telecommunication Union, CDEMA, the UNDP together with host country Barbados, are jointly organizing an event, "Multi-stakeholder Forum on the Role of Telecommunications/ICT in Disaster Management and Climate Change", to be held in Bridgetown, Barbados from 18-20 September 2013.

This sub-regional event will bring together national agencies involved in disaster Risk reduction and disaster management, private telecommunications entities, United Nations Agencies, and Non-Governmental Organizations, to share knowledge, discuss and exchange views, on how to assist countries and communities to mitigate, respond and cope with natural disasters.

At the end of the event, an Action Plan will be adopted covering regulatory, legal, technical, standard operating procedures and the designing of National Emergency Telecommunications Plans.
