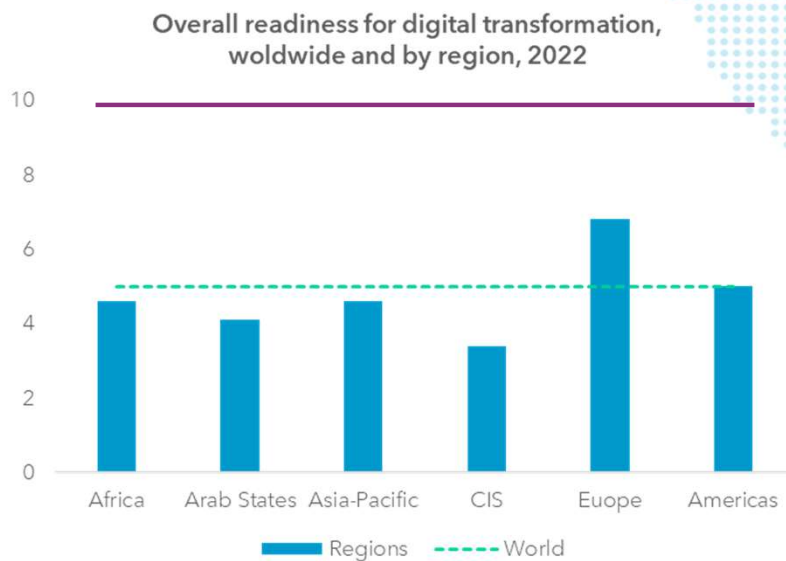

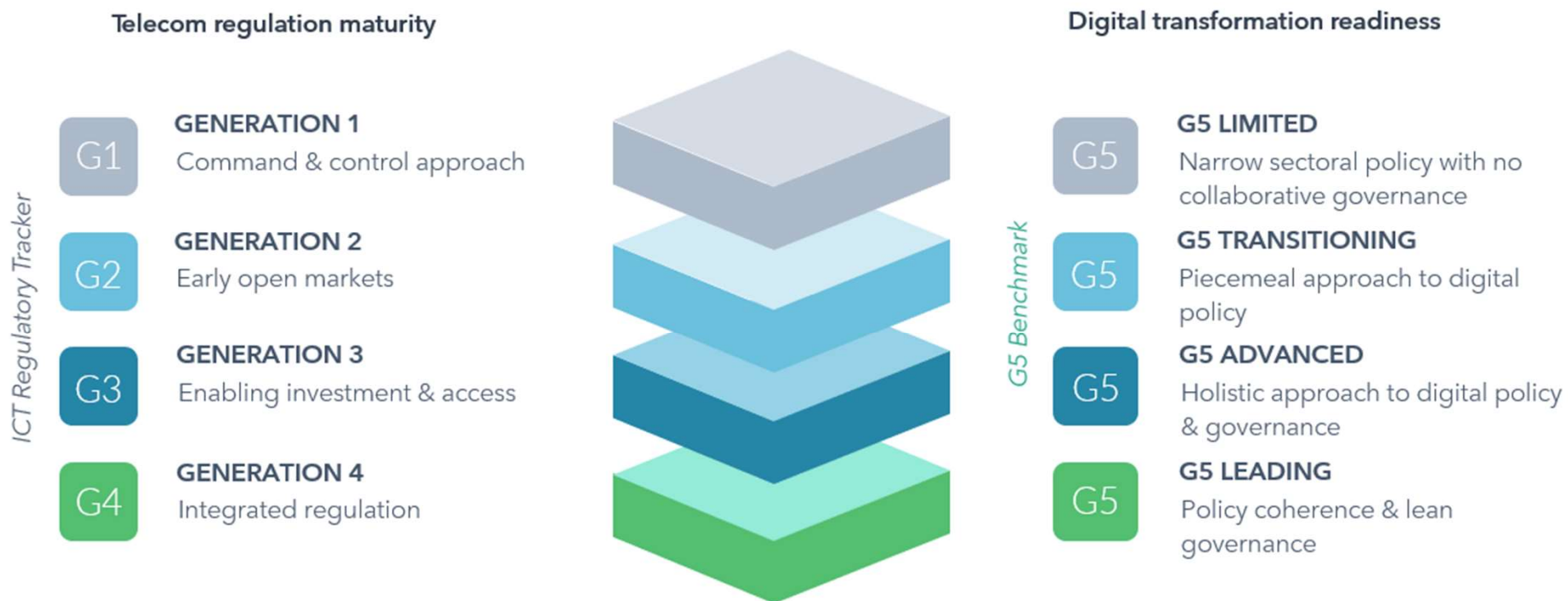
Connecting everyone, everywhere remains the absolute priority

Generations of regulation model

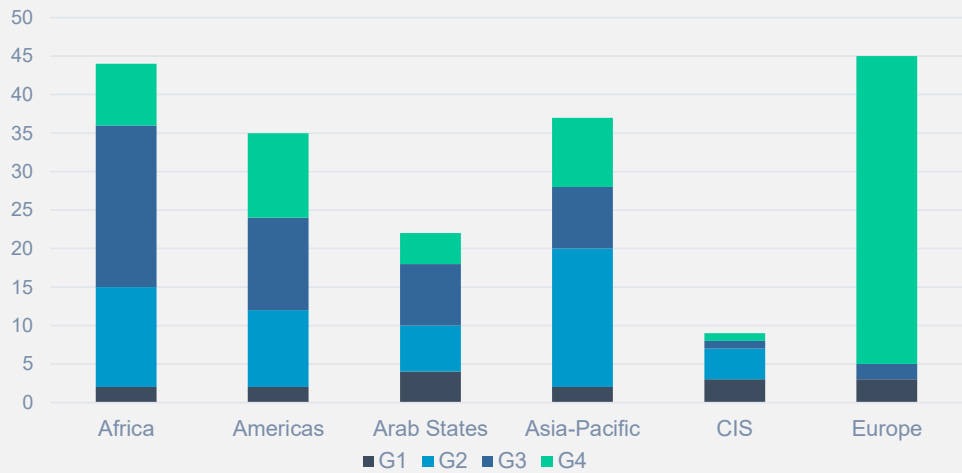

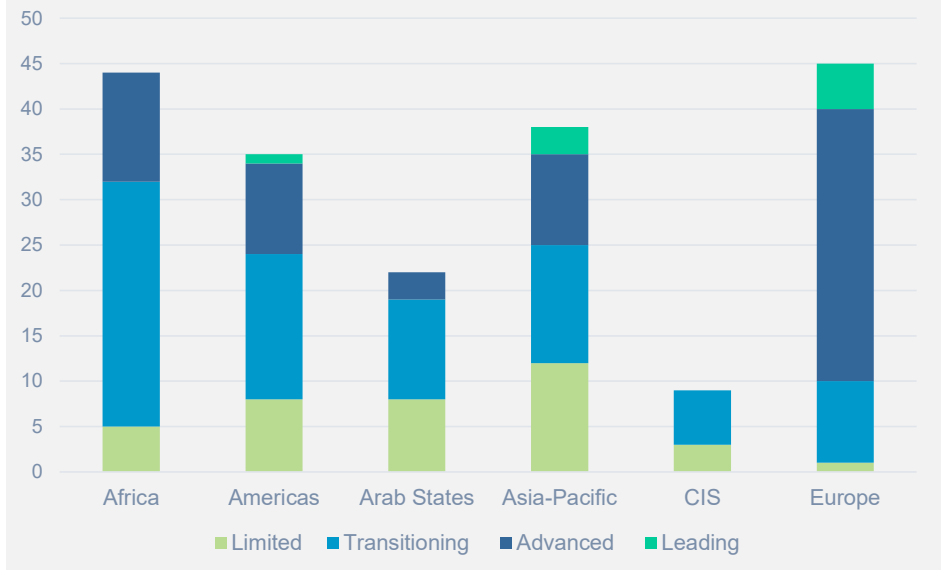
Maturity of national legal and governance frameworks



Generation of telecom/ICT regulation, by region, 2022

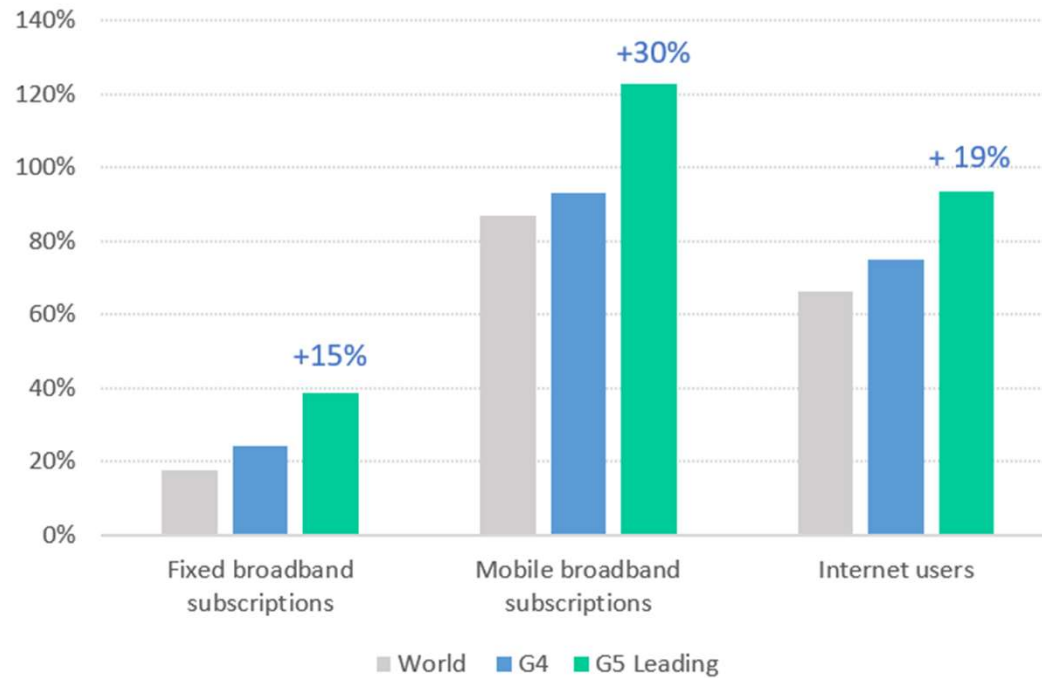


Enabling policy and governance for digital markets, by region, 2022

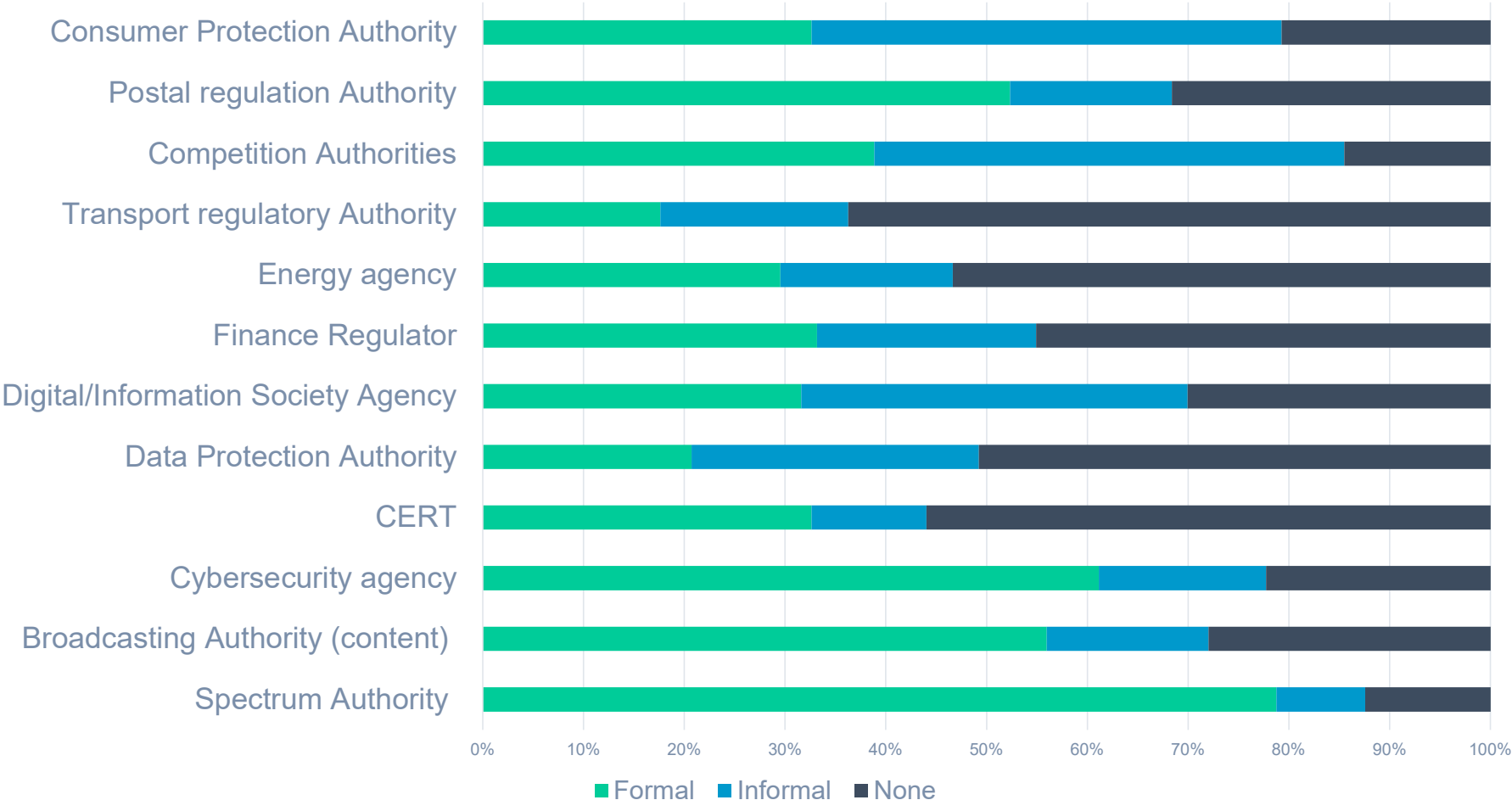


Digital transformation gaining momentum in Leading Gen 5 markets
