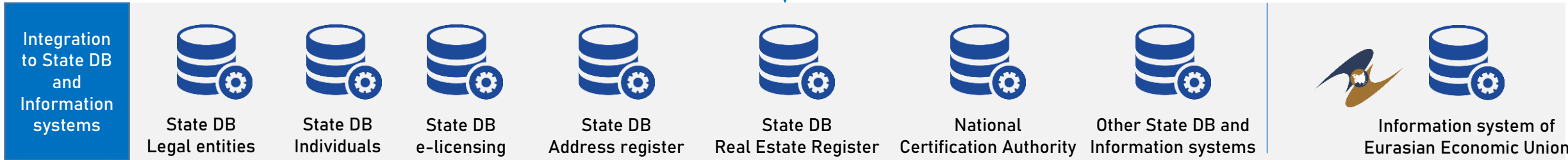
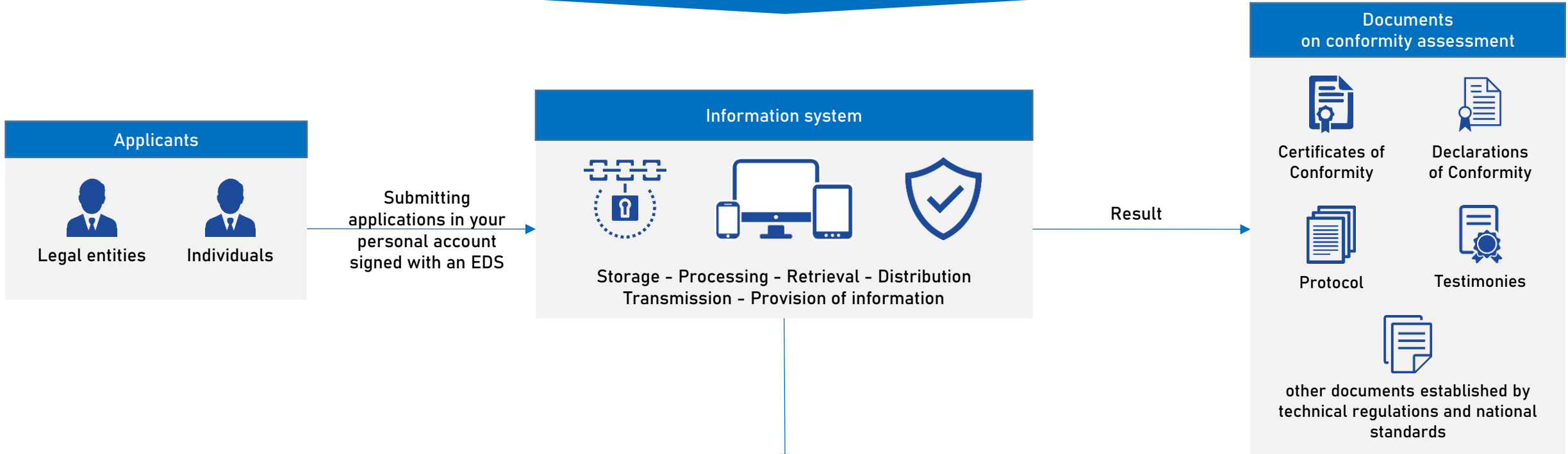
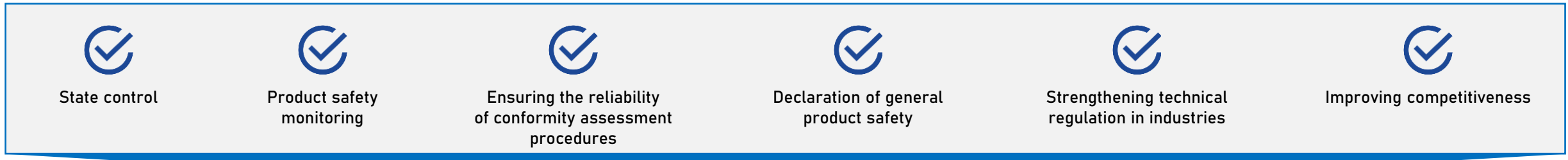

Order of the Minister of Trade and Integration of the Republic of Kazakhstan
«On approval of the rules for conformity assessment»
(effective from 1 July 2021)

- ❖ Low confidence in certification and testing results
- ❖ High level of «gray» certification
- ❖ Insufficient level of reliability, completeness and relevance of information
- ❖ Complex data analysis and high error rate
- ❖ Paper document flow (certificates, declarations, protocols, etc.)
- ❖ Use of strict reporting forms
- ❖ Issuance of documents outside the scope of accreditation of accreditation entities
- ❖ Systematic violations by accreditation entities, including technical errors by specialists of accreditation entities

-  Creation of a digital twin of the subject of accreditation. **Done**
-  Submission of applications is exclusively in electronic form. **Done**
-  Unconditional compliance with all stages and processes of certification. **Done**
-  Elimination of the possibility of issuing documents outside the scope of accreditation. **Done**
-  Issuance of documents only upon request from the applicant. **Done**
-  Creation of documents exclusively in electronic form. **Done**
-  Automatic recording of issued documents on conformity assessment. **Done**
-  Online verification of conformity assessment documents. **Done**
-  Minimal intervention of state control and inspection bodies. **In process**
